Reserve Bank of India

- The Reserve Bank of India issued new **Rs.10 denomination banknotes** in the Mahatma Gandhi (New) Series bearing signature of Governor Urjit Patel.
 - The base color of the note was chocolate brown, and will have a motif of Konark's Sun Temple.
- The Reserve Bank of India has reportedly ordered banks to **recalibrate their ATMs** to ensure that they start dispensing the **Rs. 200 denomination notes**.
 - Around 522.8 crore has been spent on the printing of 178 crore pieces of 200 banknotes till December 8.
- According to a recently released data by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), **India's foreign exchange** (Forex) **reserves** have scaled to **fresh record** high of **\$409.366 billion** as on **December 29, 2017**.
 - The surge was due to massive spike in foreign currency assets, which is key component of the reserves.
- The **Indian government's four mints** have halted **coin production** as of **January 8** owing to excess coins at the mints.
 - Over 250 crore pieces of manufactured coins in the storage rooms are waiting to be picked up by the RBI.

- The government is going to invite fresh applications for the **Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) Deputy Governor** Post although interviews were conducted last year.
 - The position remained vacant after SS Mundra retired after his three-year term on July 31, 2017.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) **reiterated** that all **14 designs of 10 coin** are legal tender for transactions.

State Bank of India

- **State Bank of India** (SBI) and **NABARD** have signed an agreement with **five NGOs in Bengal** for the promotion of **2500 Joint Liability Groups** (JLGs) in select districts of the State.
 - JLGs are informal groups of **4-10 members** engaged in **similar economic activities** and willing to jointly undertake the **responsibility** to repay loans taken by the group from a bank.
- **India's** largest lender State Bank of India (**SBI**) has announced that it will hire over **9,500 people** for **customer support** and sales functions.

Other Banks

- Union Minister Manoj Sinha announced that the government is going to roll out all 650 branches of India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) by April 2018.
- India's fifth largest private sector bank, Yes Bank and location-based social networking service
 Nearby tied up to provide Aadhaar- enabled cardless and pinless ATM service through which,
 customers can deposit or withdraw money at retailers' place.
 - Using the PayNEARBY mobile application on a smart phone, a retailer can become an Aadhaar ATM/Aadhaar Bank branch for cash withdrawals and deposits by a customer, Yes Bank said in a release.
- Finance Minister **Arun Jaitley** inaugurated the **Platinum Jubilee** (75 Years) celebrations of **UCO Bank**.
 - The bank was established on 6th January 1943 by Ghanshyam das Birla.
- Paytm Payments Bank has partnered IndusInd Bank to introduce a facility to create a fixed deposit when the customer balance exceeds Rs.1 lakh at the end of day.
 - Paytm Payments Bank customers can redeem their deposits instantly, anytime without paying any pre-closure or miscellaneous charges and can earn up to 6.85% annual interest.
 - If a customer becomes a senior citizen before the maturity period, the account will be auto renewed under the senior citizen scheme, thus earning higher interest.
- Andhra Pradesh Grameena Vikas Bank (APGVB) operationalzed its first desktop ATM in Warangal (Telangana), to facilitate customers to withdraw small amounts.
 - Desktop ATM has low power requirements and is designed to work in harsh climatic conditions.
- Punjab National Bank (PNB) and National Scheduled Castes Finance and Development Corporation (NSFDC) have signed an MOU to provide financial assistance for economic empowerment of persons belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) families living below Double Poverty Line (DPL).
 - Under this tie-up, PNB would act as a channelizing agent for the loan schemes of NSFDC.
- The Ministry of housing and urban affairs and Allahabad Bank signed a MoU to provide a centralized platform for processing interest subsidy under the self employment programme component of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihood Mission.
- The **Indian Banks' Association** (IBA) has announced that there is no proposal to **discontinue free banking services** and asked people not to pay heed to 'baseless rumors'.
 - This comes after reports that public sector banks will cease free services from January 20.

- **IDFC Bank's** board has approved a takeover of financial firm **Capital First** in a share swap deal.
 - Shareholders of Capital First will get **139 shares of IDFC Bank** for every 10 held.
 - The merger will form a combined entity with assets under management of 88,000 crore, branch network of 194 and customer base of over 5 million.
- **IndusInd Bank** and **Dynamics Inc** announced plans to introduce the first battery-powered, interactive **payment cards** in the **Indian market** in **2018**.
 - This new card has multiple buttons that let the consumer use a single card to pay in multiple ways.
- Federal Bank has entered into a strategic partnership with Hedge Equities Ltd for providing Portfolio Investment Scheme (PIS) services to NRIs.
- Private sector lender **HDFC Bank** became the first Indian bank to cross **5 trillion** (about \$78 billion) market capitalization.
 - The bank is also only the third Indian company to achieve this milestone after **Tata Consultancy Services** (TCS) and **Reliance Industries**.
- Bank of Baroda tied up with Digital invoice discounting marketplace Invoicemart, as TReDS (Trade Receivables Electronic Discounting System) partner.
 - Invoice mart is a joint venture between Axis Bank and m-junction services.
- Paytm Payments Bank Savings Account holders can now order physical debit cards from the Paytm app.
 - Earlier the bank provided only a Digital Rupay card which was linked to a user's Paytm Payments Bank savings account.
- The Centre announced it would infuse **88,139 crore** as capital into **20 state-owned banks** during the current fiscal.
 - **IDBI Bank** will get the most at **10,610 crore**, followed by **Bank of India** and **SBI** which will receive **9,232 crore** and **8,800 crore** respectively.
 - This is the first batch of the **2.11 lakh crore** recapitalization plan announced last year.
- Bhopal-based **Prodigee Finance Limited** received **Non Banking Financial Company** NBFC license from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
 - This NBFC license from RBI makes it possible for the firm to provide Small and Medium sized Enterprises (SME) loans as part of their services.
 - CEO of Prodigee Finance Limited: Amit Goel
- Rating agency **CRISIL** has revised its outlook on **18 public sector banks** (PSBs) from "**negative**" to "**stable**" after the government announced bank-wise capital infusion and reform plans.

Insurance

- Banking finance company **AU Small Finance Bank** has signed a MoU with **Life Insurance Corporation** (LIC) to offer **Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana** (PMJJBY).
 - Under the MoU, LIC will give a life cover of **Rs 2 lakh** in case of **death** to the **customer** at a nominal premium of **Rs 330 per annum**.

Supreme Court

• **Modifying** its order on the **National Anthem**, **Supreme Court** announced that it is **not mandatory** to **play** the anthem in **cinema halls before** movie screenings.

High Courts and Sessions Courts

- A special **CBI court** sentenced **Rashtriya Janata Dal** chief **Lalu Prasad Yadav** along with other convicts to **3.5 years in jail** in the 89-lakh **fodder scam case**.
 - The scam was exposed in 1996, leading to Yadav's resignation as the **Bihar** CM.

- Patiala House Court in Delhi has become the first trial court to have a permanent National Flag across the country.
 - The 50-feet high Tricolour, installed by the Central Public Works Department, was unfurled by the Delhi High Court Acting Chief Justice Gita Mittal.

Election Commission

- The Election Commission has announced that the polling for legislative assembly elections in Tripura will be held on February 18, while polling in Meghalaya and Nagaland will be held on February 27.
 - The counting for all three states will be held on March 3. EVMs and VVPATs will be used in all three states.
- The **Electronic Voting Machines** (EVMs) to be employed during the by-poll in **Rajasthan's Ajmer**, **Alwar** and **Mandalgarh** constituencies will carry photographs of candidates. The EVMs will also display names of the candidates and the party symbol.

Central Government

- The Centre has made it **mandatory** for **e-commerce firms** to display the **maximum retail price** (MRP) on goods.
 - Amendments in this regard were made to the Legal Metrology (packaged commodities) Rules in June 2017.
 - Along with MRP, the companies have to display manufacturing and expiry date, net quantity, country of origin and consumer care details on the label.
- The Union Cabinet has approved a proposal that government will bear the Merchant Discount Rate (MDR) charges on transactions up to Rs.2000 made through Debit Cards, BHIM UPI or Aadhaar-enabled payment systems to promote digital transactions.
 - This rule comes into force from 1st January 2018.
- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) approved construction, operation and maintenance of 2-lane bi-directional Zojila Tunnel on Srinagar-Leh section connecting NH-1A in Jammu and Kashmir.
 - The strategic tunnel will provide all-weather connectivity to strategically important Leh region. On completion, **Zoijila Tunnel** will be Asia's largest 2-lane bi-directional tunnel.
- The government has sought **Parliament's** approval to **issue bonds** worth **80,000 crore** to **fund capital infusion** into **public-sector banks**.
 - This forms a part of the **2.11-trillion capital infusion plan** announced by the government in October, 2017.
 - The government is expected to issue recapitalization bonds worth **1.35 trillion** under the plan.
- The Union Cabinet cleared a proposal allowing **100**% **foreign direct investment** (FDI) in **single-brand retail via automatic route**.
 - This move makes it easier for foreign brands to fully own their **Indian stores** when earlier they needed to **partner with local brands**.
- The Union Cabinet has decided to fix three-year term of Chairperson and the Members of the board of the National Trust, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.
- To tackle crimes like **cyber threats**, child pornography and online stalking, the government is going to set up a **Cyber Warrior Police Force** (CWPF).
- The government has announced **April 1** as the deadline for the **mandatory installation** of **Global Positioning System** (GPS) **devices** and **panic buttons** in all passenger transport vehicles, including **taxis and buses**.
 - Three-wheelers like **e-rickshaws** and **auto rickshaws** have been exempted from the rule.

- As a part of its policy to 'empower minorities without appeasement', the Indian Government decided to end **Haj subsidy** from this year.
 - The government has announced that it has reduced additional **borrowing target** for this fiscal by **60% to 20,000 crore** from the earlier announced Rs.50,000 crore.
- The Centre added 9 cities including **Bareilly**, **Silvassa and Moradabad**, under its **Smart Cities Mission**, taking the total number of cities selected for the scheme to 99.
 - The nine cities have proposed an investment of over Rs.12,800 crore for undertaking around 409 infrastructural projects, including rejuvenation of water bodies, development of smarts roads and classrooms, among others.
- The **Union government** has approved setting up of the long-awaited **Indian Institute of Information Technology** (IIIT) at **Raichur** (Karnataka).
 - This is 2nd IIIT in Karnataka after one in Dharwad.
- The Central government announced recently that the **Payments banks** such as **Airtel payments bank and small finance banks** such as **Utkarsh** and **ESAF** will also **offer social security scheme**, **Atal Pension Yojana** (APY), to their subscribers.
- Acid attack victims, people with Autism, Mental Illnesses, and Intellectual Disabilities, will now get reservation for central government jobs.
 - In case of direct recruitment, 4% of the total number of vacancies will be reserved for people with benchmark disabilities.
 - Benchmark disability means a person with not less than 40% of a specified disability.
- To deal with **cybercrimes**, the **Union Home Ministry** is going to set up **Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre** (I4C), an apex coordination centre in **New Delhi**.
- The government has **reversed** its decision to issue **Orange colored passports** to people requiring **emigration check** amid **criticism** that it might lead to **discrimination and segregation**.
 - The orange passports identify people who don't file taxes and are not educated beyond Class 10.
- To counter **Islamic radicalization** of **youth**, the Centre has proposed the adoption of the 'Singapore Model'.
 - Under this model, there would be a religious rehabilitation mechanism with help from popular scholars and community leaders, instead of an extended criminal trial for the radicalized youth.

States

- The **Telangana** government launched a round-the-clock **power supply** to the state's **23 lakh** farmers free of cost.
- Arunachal Pradesh emerged as the second State in the Northeast, after Sikkim, to be declared Open Defecation Free.
 - Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, and Haryana were already declared open defecation free states in October 2017.
- Kolkata is set to get its first floating market, named 'The Floating Market of Patuli', which is likely to be open for public in January.
- The **Karnataka** state government is going to purchase **640 electric vehicles** (40 buses, 100 cars and 500 three-wheelers) under the Central government's **FAME India** subsidized scheme.
- The **Uttar Pradesh Transport Department** is going to introduce the **Vehicle registration** number portability.
 - The Vehicle Registration Number Portability allows the vehicle owners to retain vehicle numbers even if they sell it.

- **Hyderabad** became **2**nd **large city** (above 1 crore population) to be declared **open defecation free** (ODF), after **Mumbai**.
- West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee unveiled the Official emblem of the West Bengal State government.
 - The logo, designed by the Chif Minister herself, highlights the **Ashoka emblem** on the **top** with the **theme** of "**Biswa Bangla**" at the centre.
- India's 1st park for people with special needs was inaugurated by Telangana Urban Development Minister KT Rama Rao in Hyderabad.
 - The park has a speech therapist, a physiotherapist, and vocational training instructors for differently-abled children.
- Bihar government has banned manufacture, distribution, sale, purchase, display, and advertisement of electronic cigarettes in the state.
- **Haryana** became first state to launch **High-Risk Pregnancy** (HRP) **Portal**, to help in early identification of high-risk pregnant cases and ensure their timely referral to civil hospital.
 - This portal is designed to track every **high-risk pregnant woman** till **42 days after delivery**.
- In a bid to end the practice of manual scavenging, the **Kerala** government is procuring **50 robots** which are developed to **clean sewer holes**.
 - The robot, named 'Bandicoot', has been developed by Kerala-based startup 'Genrobotics'.
- **Delhi** Chief Minister **Arvind Kejriwal** launched a **Common card** for **rides** on **public buses** and the **metro**.
 - With this **Delhi** became the **first city in the country** to have a common mobility card.
- Haryana has recorded its Highest Sex Ratio at birth with 914 girls per 1,000 boys in 2017.
 - Haryana had recorded the worst sex ratio at birth in the 2011 Census with 834 girls per 1,000 boys.
- West Bengal government has launched a Water ATM project to provide bacteria-free drinking water in schools.
- Odisha State Government announced a scheme titled 'Mukshyamantri Kalakar Sahayata Jojana' (MMKSJ).
 - Under this scheme, artists from across the state will get a monthly assistance of Rs 1200.
 - This scheme will benefit around **50000 artists** from across state.
- The **Maharashtra** government has announced a **1**% **reservation** in **government jobs** and **education for orphans** in the state.
 - The reservation will be provided under the **general category** and the state won't increase its caste reservation quota.
- The **Haryana government** has decided to form a **Non-Banking Financial Company** (NBFC) titled **Haryana State Financial Services Limited** (HSFSL).
 - It will enable quick and hassle-free lending and create financial discipline among the State government entities.
- Maharashtra became 1st state to unveil Public Cloud Policy that virtually mandates state government departments to shift their data storage onto cloud.
- Madhya Pradesh became 1st state to completely implement door-to-door garbage collection in all urban areas, using measures like solid waste management at landfill sites and processing through Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode.
- Maharashtra state government has banned the sale of tobacco at shops selling fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG).

- The Maharashtra government has launched `Balasaheb Thackeray Shaheed Sanmaan' scheme, under which family members of martyrs would be provided jobs with the Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC).
- Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur launched 24X7 'Gudiya' helpline.
 - Named after a 16-year old rape and murder victim of Kotkhai, Gudia is used for quick police response cases of crimes against women.
 - The Chief Minister also launched 'Shakti Button'- a mobile app linked to police control rooms for ensuring the safety of women in the state.
- The **Maharashtra government** has decided to hire **30 public relations officers**, one for each of the 30 ministers, for an estimated cost of 90 lakh per year.
- To promote organic farming, the **Himachal Pradesh Government** has launched **Zero Budget Natural Farming** (ZBNF) **project**.
 - This project aims to increase agriculture produce and the **income of farmers** by the year **2022**.

Place in the News

- The 150-metre-high **Dubai Frame** has opened nearly a decade after it was first designed.
 - The structure features a 93-metre-long glass observation deck and a neon-lit tunnel which leads **visitors** to an **interactive exhibition** on the **future of Dubai**.
 - The structure was built at a cost of **Dh160 million** (approximately 280 crore).
- Arunachal Pradesh is going to get its first Film and Television Institute (FTII).
 - This would be the **second** such one in the country. The **first** Film and Television Institute of India (FTII) was set up in **Pune** in 1960.
- Kolkata became first metro city in India to get floating market.
 - The floating market is located on lake at **Patuli in South Kolkata** which is 400 metres long and 60 metres wide.

Defence and National Security ENNAI SCHOOL OF BANKING

- The Home Ministry has declared Nagaland a "disturbed area" under Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act (AFSPA) for six more months till June-end.
- Defence Minister **Nirmala Sitharaman** approved the purchase of **240 precision-guided bombs** worth 1,254 crore for the **Air Force** and **131 Barak missiles** worth 460 crore for the **Navy**.
- India has signed 187 defence deals to procure military platforms and equipment from domestic and foreign firms in the last four years.
 - The total value of the defence deals signed amounts to **2.8 lakh crore**.
 - Around 63% deals were signed with Indian vendors.
- India has cancelled a 3,174-crore deal to buy 1,600 Spike anti-tank guided missiles with Israeli state-owned defence company Rafael Advanced Defense Systems.
 - India wasn't keen on the deal as its military research body DRDO was working on creating its own missiles.
- The **Indian Coast Guard** (ICG) has commissioned **Charlie-435**, a state-of-the-art patrol vessel at **Karaikal** in the Union Territory of **Puducherry**.
 - With commissioning of Charlie-435, the Coast Guard station at **Karaikal** now has **five vessels**.
- After serving the **Navy** for 30 and 28 years respectively, Indian Navy has decommissioned **INS Nirbhik** and **INS Nirghat** warships at **Naval Dockyard**, **Mumbai** (Maharashtra).
- The **Indian Navy** is planning to acquire its 3rd **Aircraft carrier** for 1.6 lakh crore along with 57 twinengine fighter planes.

- While the Navy has one operational aircraft carrier, INS Vikramaditya, its second carrier, INS Vikrant, is under construction and is expected to join service in the next few years.
- Indo-US joint military exercise Vajra Prahar was held at Joint Base Lewis-McChord (JBLM) in Seattle (USA).
- The **Defence Acquisition Council**, led by **Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman**, has approved the procurement of 72,000 assault rifles and around **94,000 carbines** worth Rs.**3500 crore** on a **fasttrack** basis.
- **India** test-fired the nuclear-capable inter-continental ballistic missile **Agni-V**, whose range includes the northernmost part of **China**.
 - It has been successfully tested four times before and may be inducted into the Strategic Forces Command (SFC).
- Indian Air Force was showcasing the indigenously developed weapon system integrated helicopter Rudra for the first time in the Republic Day parade.
 - The formation of the fly past was including a helicopter carrying the **ASEAN flag**.
- Indian Navy launched INS Karanj, the third of the six indigenous Scorpene-class submarines.
 - The submarine, equipped with superior stealth features and precision-guided weapons, has been built at Mumbai's Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited.
- Nirmala Sitharaman became the first full-time Defence Minister to fly in a Sukhoi 30 MKI of the Indian Air Force.
 - The Sukoi-30 MKI is a nuclear-capable aircraft which can penetrate deep into enemy territory.
- Indian Naval Ship Vikramaditya, the Indian Navy's largest ship and its sole aircraft carrier was formally affiliated to the Indian Army's Bihar Regiment.
- The second indigenously built offshore patrol vessel (OPV) named Vijaya built by Larsen and Toubro (L&T) Shipyard for Indian Coast Guard (ICG) was launched at Kattupalli Shipyard, Tamil Nadu.
 - It is expected to be inducted into service by September 2018 after trials on the equipment.
- **SARAS PT1N**, the new upgraded version of **SARAS**, the indigenous **transport aircraft** developed by **National Aeronautics Laboratory**, successfully made its maiden flight in **Bangalore**.
- Indigenously developed surveillance aircraft 'Netra', also known as 'eye in the sky', flew over Rajpath for the first time as part of the Republic Day parade.
 - Netra is an Airborne Early Warning and Control (AEW&C) aircraft with a 200-km range, and was inducted by the IAF last year.
- The **Vietnam-India Bilateral Army EXercise** (VINBAX2018) was recently held at **Jabalpur** (Madhya Pradesh).
 - VINBAX-2018 is the first military exercise between India and Vietnam.
- Pakistan's Navy successfully test-fired its indigenously-built naval cruise missile 'Harba' in the Arabian Sea.
 - The missile was launched from newly commissioned attack vessel PNS Himmat, which is around 63 metres long and is fitted with state-of-the-art sensors and weapons.

Committees/Commissions

- The government that formed a **4 Member Ministerial** committee to decide what to do with old, **pre-existing projects in ports**, which have become unviable.
 - Head of this Committee : **Arun Jaitley (Finance Minister)**

- The Election Commission (EC) has constituted 14 member committee to suggest changes to Section 126 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (RP Act) in view of social media expansion.
 - Head of this Committee **Umesh Sinha** (Chief Election Commissioner)
- Less than three months after it was set up, the **Committee of Governors** submitted a report on best practices to President **Ram Nath Kovind**.
 - The report titled 'Rajyapal -Vikas Ke Rajdoot: Catalytic Role of Governors as Agents for Change in Society', focuses on key work areas of development and the role that governors can play in taking this forward.
 - The 5 member committee comprised governors E.S.L.Narasimhan (Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, Banwarilal Purohit (Tamil Nadu), Ram Naik (Uttar Pradesh), Tathagata Roy (Tripura) and Acharya Devvrat (Himachal Pradesh).

Schemes/Initiatives

- To provide information on all **central and state government schemes** for women, the **Women and Child Development Ministry** launched a **web portal** titled **NARI**.
- The **Union Finance Ministry** has launched **7.75% Savings (Taxable) Bonds, 2018 scheme** to help citizens invest in a taxable instrument, without any monetary ceiling.
 - It will enable resident citizens/Hindu Undivided Families (HUF) to invest in a taxable bond, without any monetary ceiling.
- The Atal Pension Yojana (APY) run by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) has reached a subscriber base of 80 lakh.
 - Uttar Pradesh is the highest contributing state at 11.41 lakh APY subscribers, followed by Bihar and Tamil Nadu at 8.87 lakh and 6.60 lakh respectively.
- To provide institutionalized **socio-economic security** for the **workers** in the **unorganized sector**, the **Jammu and Kashmir** government is set to launch a scheme called "**Muhafiz** (**Guardian**)".
 - Under this scheme, around three lakh workers registered with Jammu and Kashmir Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board (JKBOCWWB) will be provided accidental, life and disability insurance, besides educational scholarships to their children under it.
 - The scheme also envisages extending micro credit facility to such workers and facilitating their registration through online and other modes.

 Act, 1981.
 - The Act establishes NABARD for providing and regulating facilities like credit for agricultural and industrial development in the rural areas.

- Lok Sabha has passed **The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains** (Amendment) Bill, 2017 to allow government to take up infrastructure projects within prohibited areas around protected monuments.
 - This Bill amends the **Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains (AMASR) Act, 1958**.
- Amid a string of rape incidents in Haryana, the state is going to enact a law providing **death penalty** for **rapists of girls** aged **12 years and below**.

Fund

- **India** has granted a **financial assistance** worth over **288 crore** (\$45.27 million) to develop **Sri Lanka's Kankesanthurai** (KKS) **Harbour** into a commercial port.
 - The move is aimed at strengthening **Sri Lanka's efforts** to become a **regional maritime hub**.
 - The **KKS Harbour** was destroyed by the **LTTE during Sri Lanka's civil war**.
- With USD 1.5 billion worth of loans in 2017, **India** becomes **top** borrower from **Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank** (AIIB).
 - Indonesia stood at second spot with USD 600 million worth loans.
- The government is going to set up a **2,200-crore fund** to **finance solar projects** to achieve its target of having **175 GW** in **renewable energy** by **2022**.
- The **Maharashtra** government has approved a **Rs 4,000- crore** project aimed at promoting climate-resilient agriculture, to be partially funded by the **World Bank**.
- Japan has committed JICA Official Development Assistance loan for an amount of 45 billion yen (about Rs 2,587 crore) for Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Project (Phase 3).
- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Government of India signed a \$250 million loan agreement to finance the construction of 6,254 kilometres all-weather rural roads in the States of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and West Bengal under the Prime Minister's Rural Roads Program (PMGSY).

- According to a recently released census of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), **Mauritius** was the largest source of **Foreign Direct Investment** (FDI) in **India**, followed by the **US** and **UK** in 2016-17.
- Chief Economic Adviser Arvind Subramanian has drafted the Economic Survey for the year 2017-18 in Parliament.
 - This survey predicted India's GDP growth at **7-7.5**% in the next fiscal.
 - The survey claimed that **collection of direct taxes** by **Indian states and local governments** is significantly **lower compared to other countries**.

- The Economic Survey 2017-18 tabled in Parliament has been printed in **Pink** to highlight **gender issues** amid economic development.

 - Called the 'Telegram Open Network' (TON), it is designed to host a new generation of crypto currencies and decentralized applications.
- Chinese e-commerce giant Alibaba-owned messaging app DingTalk unveiled an English version in India that caters to the small and medium-sized enterprises.
- Samsung India has launched a new shopping app and service, called Samsung Mall, exclusively for the Indian market.
 - The app offers visual searching of products online and provides an interface to shop across different e-commerce sites, like **Amazon** and **Flipkart**.
- Facebook-owned messaging service WhatsApp is going to launch its digital payments feature in India
 - WhatsApp is working with State Bank of India, HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank, and Axis Bank to integrate its Unified Payments Interface (UPI) - based payments platform.
- American online social media and social networking website Facebook has launched its 'Marketplace' to buy and sell used goods and services across categories such as electronics, entertainment, and housing in India.
- Chkfake Brand Protection Solutions announced the launch of 'Chkfake'- a unique global platform which allows users to check authenticity of currency notes of any major currency globally.
- Technology giant **Apple** has partnered with **Malala Fund** to support **girls' education**, thereby becoming its **first Laureate partner**.

- The **GST** Council has decided to put **29** handicraft items in the **0**% tax slab and reduce rates on **53** services.

Space

- To explore the sun's outer atmosphere, the **National Aeronautics and Space Administration** (NASA) is going to launch **Parker Solar Probe** in this year 2018.
- The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) is launching two new missions this year to explore the starting point of space, nearly 100 km above Earth's surface.
 - The missions GOLD and ICON would make complementary observations from different points said NASA.
 - GOLD Global-scale Observations of the Limb and Disk
 - ICON Ionospheric Connection Explorer
- ISRO's commercial arm, **Antrix**, earned **288.75 crore** by launching satellites for other countries in the last financial year.
 - To date, ISRO has launched over **200 foreign satellites**, including **101 nanosatellites** in its record launch in **February 2017**.
 - The **US** had become **ISRO's biggest client** with 96 of the 101 foreign satellites hailing from there.
- **Indian Space Research Organization** (ISRO) successfully launched its **100**th **satellite** from **Sriharikota spaceport** in **Andhra Pradesh**, along with 30 other satellites.
 - India's weather observation Cartosat-2 series satellite was the heaviest satellite, weighing 710 kg.
- China successfully launched two BeiDou-3 satellites to provide navigation and positioning services to countries along Belt and Road initiative (BRI) by the end of 2018.
 - The two satellites were designated as BeiDou-3 M7 and BeiDou-3 M8 (26th and 27th satellites) in BeiDou Navigation Satellite System (BDS).
- **Japan's Aerospace Exploration Agency** (JAXA) successfully launched a **new Earth observation satellite**, equipped with **X-band radar** which is capable of obtaining high-resolution terrain images.

- The Advanced Satellite with New System Architecture for Observation (ASNARO-2) was launched aboard a third-generation Epsilon rocket from the Uchinoura Space Center, in the southwestern prefecture of Kagoshima, Japan.
- The **International Space Station** has completed **7,000 days** orbiting the Earth at a 400-km altitude, after its first module was launched in 1998.
- US commercial startup Rocket Lab has launched its Electron rocket into orbit and deployed three satellites for the first time.
 - Rocket Lab has also signed contracts with NASA and Seattle-based Spaceflight for small-satellite launches.

- **Taiwanese** multinational hardware and electronics company **Acer** has unveiled a **laptop**, **Swift 7 Ultrabook**, which is the world's thinnest computer with a thickness of 8.98 mm (0.35 inches).
- The Union Minister for Science and Technology Harsh Vardhan launched India's fastest and first "multi-petaflops" supercomputer 'Pratyush' at the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM) in Pune.
 - The system, which will be a national facility for **improving weather and climate forecasts**, will also help improve India's peak computing capacity from **1 petaflop to 6.8 petaflops**.
 - Petaflop is a measure of processing speed and equals a quadrillion floating point operations per second.
- Russian scientists have discovered a dinosaur species that roamed Siberia 120 million years ago named the Siberian Titan.
- Two Macaque Monkeys have become the first primates to be cloned using the same approach that produced **Dolly** the sheep, the first mammal cloned from an adult somatic cell.
 - The monkeys were named **Zhong Zhong** and **Hua Hua** after their **birthplace China** (Zhonghua in Mandarin).

- **Kazakhstan** has overtaken **Iraq** to become the biggest overproducer in the pact between **OPEC** and its allies to curb oil output.
 - OPEC Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries

- The UK's ban on plastic microbeads used in cosmetics and personal care products came into
 effect.
 - This move is aimed at protecting marine life as the small beads enter water bodies and get absorbed or eaten by the wildlife, affecting their growth.

- To make learning more interesting, the Centre has decided to launch 'Operation Digital Board'.

 - The idol was stolen from the UNESCO World Heritage Site Rani-ki-Vav in Gujarat's Patan in 2001 and smuggled out of the country.

- The **Unique Identification Authority of India** (UIDAI) announced the introduction of **Face authentication** feature for **Aadhaar** users by **July 1, 2018**.
- India became the 43rd member of the Australia Group, which counters the export of material, equipment and technologies that could create chemical and biological weapons.
 - In 2016, India had joined the Missile Technology Control Regime, aimed at restricting missile proliferation.
 - Last year, India joined the Wassenaar Arrangement, which controls export of conventional weapons.

 - After the ceremony, the Finance Ministry officials are not allowed to leave the printing press until the Budget is presented on 1st February 2018.
- China is going to build a 'Great Wall' along the border of the Muslim-dominated Xinjiang province to prevent infiltration by militants.

- The **US** state of **California** legalized the sale of **recreational marijuana**, over 20 years after legalizing its **medical use**. With this, it has become the **sixth US** state to do so.
- **Iceland** has become the **first country** in the world to make it **illegal** to **pay men more than women.**
- North Korea has accepted South Korea's proposal to hold official talks to discuss inter-Korean relations and its possible participation in the Winter Olympics in South Korea next month.
 - These will be the first high-level talks between the two after a communication gap of more than two years.
- The United States has placed Pakistan on 'Special Watch List' for "severe violations" of religious freedom.
 - Pakistan is the only country to be put under the newly-formed list.
- Pakistan has decided to allow the Chinese yuan to be used for imports, exports and financing transactions for bilateral trade and investment activities.
- China is planning to build its second overseas military base in Pakistan near the Gwadar port.
 - The base would be used to dock and maintain naval vessels, as well as provide other logistical support services.
- The **South Australian** government has approved a proposal of a US-based company to build the world's largest **solar-thermal power plant** in the **Australian state**.
 - The 150-megawatt plant which worths over **3,200 crore**, will create **650 construction jobs** and 50 ongoing positions when completed.
- The **Ecuadorian Foreign Ministry** announced that it has granted citizenship to **WikiLeaks** founder **Julian Assange**.
- For the first time in more than 60 years, the **Sri Lankan government** announced that it is going to **allow women over the age of 18** to buy **alcohol legally**.
- Nepal has started accessing internet from China after commercial operation of Nepal-China optical fibre link via Rasuwagadhi gateway across Himalayan Mountains became operational.
 - This project now ends Nepal's sole dependence on India for internet bandwidth. Both revenue wise and strategically, it is a big loss for India.
- Turkmenistan President Gurbanguly Berdimuhamedoy has issued an order banning women from driving in the country.
- China has set up world's first **3D-printed bus stops** in **Fengjing** (Shanghai). The bus stops have a closed loop design, accommodating two-round stools inside the structure.
- The US officially opened its new embassy in London which is believed to be the world's most expensive embassy.
 - The embassy worths over **6,400 crore** and is designed like a **crystalline cube**.
- China has constructed a 330-foot tall air purifying tower dubbed the "world's biggest air purifier".
 - The tower, which is being tested by researchers, has produced more than **10 million** cubic meters of clean air since it was launched.
- The government of **Iran** has lifted restrictions on use of **Internet**, including messaging app **Telegram**.
 - These restrictions were put after **protests** against unemployment and rising consumer prices in December 2017.
