Reserve Bank of India

- The **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) announced that it has imposed a **penalty** of **Rs.2 crore** on **Indian Overseas Bank** after a "fraud was detected" at one of its branches. It said the bank failed to comply with **Know Your Customer** (KYC) **regulations**.
 - The RBI has also imposed a penalty of Rs.3 crore on Axis Bank for violation of bad loan classification norms.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) has levied a **Rs.40 lakh** penalty on **State Bank of India** (SBI) for violating rules of detection and **impounding** of **counterfeit notes**.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) has **imposed** a penalty of **Rs.5 crore** on **Airtel Payments Bank** for breaching **Know Your Customer** (KYC) norms.
 - The fine was imposed after the RBI found it guilty of opening payments bank accounts of subscribers without their consent.
- The **Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India** (IBBI) signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) for increased **cooperation** in **effective** implementation of **insolvency law**.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) has discontinued the issuance of **Letters of Undertaking** (LoUs) and **Letters of Comfort** (LoCs) for **import trade credits**.
 - An LoU is an assurance given by one bank to another to meet liabilities on a customer's behalf.
- According to recently revealed RBI data, as much as **Rs.11302 crore** belonging to over **3 crore account holders** is lying **unclaimed** with **64 banks**.
 - The largest amount of Rs.1262 crore is lying with State Bank of India (SBI). Punjab National Bank (PNB) stood at 2nd position with Rs.1250 crore.
- The issuer of Indian currency, Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced that it is going to issue **Rs 350 coin** to mark the **350th birth anniversary of Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji**.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has **penalized** India's third-largest lender **ICICI Bank** with 58.9 crore for failing to comply with **held-to-maturity** (HTM) guidelines.

State Bank of India

- India's largest lender **State Bank of India** (SBI) has **increased Marginal Cost-based Lending Rates** (MCLR) across most maturities, making home, education, and auto loans more expensive.
 - The bank raised the key one-year MCLR rate to **8.15% from 7.95%**, effective immediately.
- India's largest lender State Bank of India (SBI) **slashed charges** for **non-maintenance of Average Monthly Balance** (AMB) for customers in **Metro and Urban centres** from a maximum of **Rs.50 per month** to **Rs.15 per month**.
 - Similarly, for Semi-Urban and Rural centres, the charges have been reduced from Rs.40 to Rs.12 and Rs.10 respectively.
 - The changes, effective **April 1**, will benefit 25 crore savings account customers.

- The Cheque Books of 6 Banks that merged with State Bank of India (SBI) will become invalid after March 31.
- India's largest lender **State Bank of India** (SBI) and **India Mortgage Guarantee Corporation** (IMGC) have signed an agreement to offer **mortgage guarantee scheme** for prospective non-salaried and self-employed home loan customers.

Other Banks

- The scam-hit **Punjab National Bank** (PNB) **raised** its **lending rate** by **15 basis** points to **8.30**% with immediate effect.
 - The bank also **increased** its **retail** and **build deposit rates** by up **45 basis** points on various maturities.

- ICICI Bank CEO Chanda Kochhar and Axis Bank MD Shikha Sharma have been summoned by the Serious Fraud Investigation Office (SFIO) in the PNB fraud case.
 - They have been called in connection with working capital loans given to **Mehul Choksi-owned Gitanjali Gems**.
 - ICICI Bank had led a 31-lender consortium which gave loans worth **Rs.5280 crore** to the company.
- The **Punjab National Bank** (PNB) has requested the **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) to provide it **four quarters** for making provisions against the **\$2-billion fraud** by jewellers Nirav Modi and Mehul Choksi.
- **Passport** details will be made **mandatory** for availing **loans** worth more than **Rs.50 crore** from state-owned banks, the government has announced.
 - Further, the loan application form will be modified to incorporate passport details of borrowers. The government has also asked banks to collect passport details of all existing borrowers with loans over Rs.50 crore in the next 45 days.
- Shares of **Andhra Bank Ltd** fell as much as **15.5**% to hit a 14-year low after the **Enforcement Directorate** (ED) filed a charge sheet against one of its former directors on a money laundering case.
- Private sector lender **HDFC Bank** barred the use of its **credit**, **debit** and **prepaid cards** to buy or trade in **cryptocurrencies** like **Bitcoin**.
 - Earlier, **Citibank India** also banned the use of its cards for buying cryptocurrencies.
- **ICICI Securities**, the brokerage and merchant banking arm of private sector lender ICICI Bank, was hit the **IPO market** on March 22.
 - Bank of America Merrill Lynch, Citigroup, CLSA, Edelweiss, IIFL and SBI Capital Markets are managing the ICICI Securities IPO.
- In a completely online and paperless manner, the **ICICI Bank** has launched instant overdraft **'InstaOD'** facility for **MSME** (Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises) **customers**.
 - Customers can get **overdraft** facility up **to Rs.15 lakh** for a **year** anytime, anywhere using the bank's Internet and mobile banking app.
- To enable Indian enterprises to efficiently manage their business travel expenditure, **Happay**, a business expense management solution provider, in collaboration with **HDFC bank**, introduced a new prepaid card-linked **Travel and Entertainment** (T&E) expense management solution.
 - With **Happay-HDFC Bank** prepaid cards and **Happay mobile app** in their pockets, business travelers will be able to easily seek trip advances, get trip itineraries pre-approved by management, do trip bookings and file trip expenses digitally and on the move.
- Citi Bank India has launched India's first home loan linked to the 3-month Government of India Treasury Bill benchmark rate.
- Karnataka Vikas Grameena Bank (KVGB) has launched 'Vikas She Plus', a loan scheme for women to take up new ventures or for expanding/modifying the existing enterprises.
 - This scheme provides loan up to a **maximum** of **Rs.2 lakh** with a repayment period of **60 months**.
- Private sector lender **DCB Bank** has launched a **remittance service** to facilitate customers **send money online globally**.
 - Under DCB Remit, any resident Indian can register online and transfer funds across 20 countries, including the **US**, **Canada**, **Australia**, **the UK**, **the UAE and Germany**.
- Private sector lender **Yes Bank** has launched a robotics based '**Digital export Import'** payments solution as a part of its **Yes Transact Smart Trade product suite**.
- India's 3rd largest Private sector lender, **Axis Bank** has opened a representative office in **Sharjah**, **United Arab Emirates**.

- This office is the third such Axis Bank office in the UAE after **Dubai** and **Abu Dhabi** and will engage primarily in promoting the Bank's retail products and services to non-resident Indians (NRIs).
- The **Allahabad Bank** received approval from **Ministry of Corporate Affairs** for amalgamation of its fully-owned subsidiary **All Bank Finance Ltd**. (ABFL) with itself.
- **Swiggy**, India's largest food ordering and delivery platform has partnered with **ICICI Bank**, the country's largest private sector bank by **consolidated assets**, to roll out two innovative digital solutions to facilitate a convenient and hassle-free way for its delivery partners to transfer funds to Swiggy.
- Bank of India said it has been allowed to terminate/close its Yangon representative office with effect from January 19, 2018 by Myanmar's Ministry of Planning and Finance, Directorate of Investment and Company Administration.
 - Following BoI's move, there are now only two Indian financial entities -- United Bank of India and Export-Import Bank of India - with representative offices in Yangon.
 - **State Bank of India** has a full-fledged branch there.
- Overtaking **Bank of Baroda** and **Punjab National Bank**, private sector lender **Bandhan Bank** has become **India's 8th most valued bank** with a market capitalization of over **Rs.**56,000 crore.
- **Fino Payments Bank** has said it plans to deploy multi-utility **Android-based mPoS** (mobile point-of-sale) devices across 10,000 banking points in the country in a phased manner.
- **Rivigo**, a homegrown logistics start-up that owns as well as acts as an aggregator of trucks, is tying up with **YES Bank**, **IDFC** and 10 other financial institutions to make **cheaper funds** available to **truck owners** and operators on its platform.
- Jana Small Finance Bank (formerly Janalakshmi Financial Services, India's leading microfinance company), announced the commencement of its banking operations.

Supreme Court

- In a landmark verdict, the Supreme Court gave legal **sanction** to **Passive Euthanasia**, permitting **'living will'** by patients on **withdrawing medical support** if they slip into **irreversible coma**.
- The Supreme Court ruled that government authorities **cannot charge more** than **Rs.50** as **application fee** for those seeking information under the **Right to Information** (RTI) **Act**.
 - The apex court also said authorities cannot charge more than **Rs.5** per **page** for **photocopy** and the **applicants** do not have to mention the "motive" in the **RTI application**.

High Courts and Sessions Courts

- **Punjabi** pop singer **Daler Mehndi** was **jailed** for two years by a **Patiala court** in a 2003 **human trafficking case**.
- A **Ranchi court** pronounced RJD chief **Lalu Prasad Yadav** guilty in the 4th fodder scam case.
 - Yadav has been convicted in three other fodder scam cases and is currently serving his jail sentences.

Election Commission

• The Election Commission announced that voting for Karnataka Assembly elections will take place on May 12 while the counting of the votes will be held on May 15.

Central Government

• The Union Cabinet has **cleared** the proposal for **hiking** the **salaries** of **Members of Parliament** (MPs).

- Their constituency allowance will be increased from Rs.45,000 to Rs.70,000, office expense allowance from Rs.45,000 to Rs.60,000, and the one-time furniture allowance from Rs.75,000 to Rs.1 lakh.
- The Union Cabinet approved **draft rules** to set up **National Financial Reporting Authority** (NFRA), an **independent regulator** to oversee **auditing** and **accounting standards**.
 - NFRA's jurisdiction will extend to listed and large unlisted public companies. The existing self-regulatory body, Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI), will continue to govern audits of smaller companies.
- The government has accepted the **demands** of **students protesting** against the alleged **SSC exam paper leak scam** and ordered a **CBI** inquiry into it.
- The Cabinet approved a **hike** in **Dearness Allowance** to **central government employees** and **Dearness Relief** to pensioners from 5% to 7%, with effect from January 1, 2018.
 - The hike is expected to benefit **48.41 lakh** central government employees and **61.17 lakh** pensioners.
- A parliamentary panel has asked the **Finance Ministry** to launch a "comprehensive enquiry" into the **\$2-billion PNB fraud** and submit its report within a month.
 - The panel said it is "extremely concerned" about the fraud which shows that a "small group of individuals can manipulate such a gigantic bank". The fraud was perpetrated by jewellers Nirav Modi and Mehul Choksi.
- The government recently **revealed** that nearly **25% of the overseas branches** of the state-owned **banks suffered losses** in 2016-17.
 - As many as 41 branches out of the 159 foreign branches of state-owned banks reported loss in fiscal 2016-17.
 - India's largest lender State Bank of India (SBI) topped the list with 9 loss-making foreign branches, followed by Bank of India with 8 such branches.
- Scrapping the 10,000 cap on funding for education of martyrs' children, the government cleared the way to fully fund the education of children of armed forces personnel missing, killed or disabled on duty.
- To boost the cultivation of **millets** like **ragi** and **jowar** on a mission mode to achieve nutritional security, the union government decided to declare **2018** as **'National Year of Millets**'.
- To create **public awareness** in **judicial matters**, the central government is going to install '**Justice Clocks**' at all 24 high courts soon.
 - The clocks will have **LED display** boards showing the daily rate of disposal of cases, pending cases and performance-based ranking of the courts.
- The government extended the **deadline** for linking **Aadhaar** with **Permanent Account Number** (PAN) to **June 30**.
 - This is the 4th time that the government has extended the deadline.

States

- In a first, the **Maharashtra** government has announced collaboration with online encyclopedia **Wikipedia** to **promote Marathi** globally and increase its online usage.
 - This move is aimed at providing **Marathi-speaking people** a **single platform** to interact and help reach **Maharashtrians** who have settled abroad.
- The Assam government has extended the Armed Forces Special Powers Act (AFSPA), 1958 by 6 more months in the state.
 - AFSPA gives special rights to security forces to carry out operations in "disturbed areas."
- The **Maharashtra** government announced that the **sale of Gutka**, **banned** in the state, would be made a non-bailable offence.
 - Punishment for the offence would be enhanced to three years in prison.

- On the occasion of International Women's Day, the Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** launched the **National Nutrition Mission** (NNM), and expansion of the coverage of **Beti Bachao Beti Padhao** programme, at **Jhunjhunu** in **Rajasthan**.
- The **Karnataka** government approved a **separate flag** of the **state** and will now be sent to the central government for approval.
 - The flag is a tri-color like our national flag; they are **Yellow**, **White and Red**. The **top** band is of **yellow**, the **middle** is **white** and **last** band is **red**.
- To ensure **safety of women** at **public places**, the **South Delhi Police** launched a **16 member** allwomen patrolling squad named '**Knightingales**'.
 - The squad has been given training in unarmed combat, weapon handling, and driving.
- The **Uttar Pradesh Secretariat** will go **paperless** from **April** as all 93 departments in the **Secretariat** will be connected with an **e-office system**.
- **Bangalore** observed the **2nd edition** of **Less Traffic Day**. Less Traffic Day is a campaign launched in **February 2018** to reduce air pollution and traffic congestion in the city.
 - The Transport Ministry has decided to observe it on the **second Sunday of every month**.
 - Aim: To encourage people to voluntarily opt for public transport services for combating pollution.
- The West Bengal government is going to launch a project worth Rs.700 crore to bring 50 lakh rural women under the Self Help Group (SHG) model.
- The Maharashtra Government banned the use of Plastic in time-bound manner.
 - This ban will include plastic bags, thermocol, disposable cups and plates, cutlery, non-woven polypropylene bags, plastic pouches and packaging.
- The Kerala government declared Jackfruit as the official fruit of the state.
- The **Punjab** government cleared a proposal **mandating Chief Minister** and other state ministers to pay the **income tax** on their salaries themselves.
- The Karnataka government has accepted the suggestion of an **expert panel** and sought **separate religion status** for the **Lingayat** community.
- West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has banned the display of arms during Ram Navami celebrations.
- The **Telangana** government has decided to make **Telugu** a **mandatory** subject till **Class 10** in all public and private schools.
- **Kerala** government launched an app titled '**mKeralam**'. This app offers around 100 government services through a unified interface.
- To bring technology to remote corners, the Andhra Pradesh Government launched multi-utility vehicle **NAIPUNYA RATHAM** (World on Wheels).
- The **Maharashtra** Legislative Assembly unanimously passed a resolution recommending the Centre to rename the **Kolhapur airport** as the **'Chhatrapati Rajaram Maharaj Airport'**.
- The **Uttar Pradesh** government has decided to add **'Ramji'** as **Dr BR Ambedkar's** middle name in all documents and records.

Place in the News

- After 56 years, the Government has **shifted headquarters** of **Animal Welfare Board of India** (AWBI) to **Ballabhgarh** in **Faridabad** District of **Haryana** from **Chennai**, **Tamil Nadu**.
 - The Animal Welfare Board of India was set up under Section IV of the **Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act** (1960).
 - Reason behind this shifting: For better coordination between the **Environment Ministry** and AWBI for carrying out the animal welfare activities.

- The **Union Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers** has approved proposal of setting up of **Plastic Park** in **Deoghar District**, **Jharkhand**.
 - The project will be set up at cost of Rs.120 crores in an area of 150 acres.
- Srinagar's Indira Gandhi Memorial Tulip Garden was opened for visitors.
 - This is Asia's largest **tulip garden**.
- India's 1st Insect museum with state-of-the-art amenities was unveiled at Tamil Nadu Agricultural University campus in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu.

Personalities

- The 1st Indian-origin woman in space, Kalpana Chawla was born on 17th March in the year 1962.
 Sunita Williams became the second Indian origin woman to travel into space in 2006.
- March 23 is 87th Shaheed Diwas (Martyr's Day) 87 years ago, on March 23 in 1931, **Shaheed Bhagat Singh**, **Shivaram Hari Rajguru** and **Sukhdev Thapar** were hanged by the British for their alleged involvement in the killing of **John Saunders**.

Defence and National Security

- The **Anti-Tank Guided Missile** (ATGM) **Nag** was successfully flight-tested in desert conditions against **two** tank **targets** at different ranges and timings. The missile is now ready for induction in the **Army**.
 - It is the third-generation fire-and-forget ATGM developed by the DRDO.
- The **6th** Annual **Garuda Shakti exercise** between the Special Forces of the **Indian Army** and the **Indonesian Army** was concluded at **Bandung**.
- Indian Navy's sailboat INSV Tarini, led by all-women crew, reached Cape Town, South Africa as part of Navika Sagar Parikrama expedition.
 - This stop is last phase of its maiden voyage to circumnavigate globe before it depart Cape Town and return to **Goa in April 2018**, on completion of the voyage.
- Joint investigation committee (JIC) comprising **US** and **Indian** officials has test-fired **M777 Ultra-Light Howitzers** (ULH) at **Pokhran** firing range in **Rajasthan**.
- The Andaman Nicobar naval command is organizing a multi-national mega event titled "Milan 2018" at Port Blair.
 - Theme: 'Friendship Across the Seas'
 - Purpose of Milan 2018: To enhance regional cooperation for combating Unlawful Activities at sea.
- **Russia** successfully launched high-precision aeroballistics **Kinzhal hypersonic missile** from a **MiG-31** supersonic interceptor jet.
- The **US** and **Israeli** military officials have launched a month-long joint military exercise titled "Juniper Cobra 2018".
 - The biennial drill is jointly held by the Israeli military and the US European Command (USEUCOM).
- The Indian Coast Guard (ICG) has commissioned interceptor boat ICGS C-437 at Porbandar, Gujarat as part of its efforts to strengthen coastal security.
 - ICGS C-437 shall be based at **Jakhau** under administrative and operational control of commander **Coast Guard Region** (North West).
- The Indo-French joint naval exercise Varuna-18 was recently held in Arabian Sea off Goa coast.
 - This exercise was conducted in 3 sea areas. They are, Arabian Sea, Bay of Bengal, South Western Indian Ocean.
- The **Gulf Shield 1** military exercise of 23 countries including **Gulf Cooperation Council** (GCC) member states was recently held in **Eastern Region of Saudi Arabia**.

- This exercise was organized by the **Defence Ministry of Saudi Arabia**.
- GE Aviation's GE9X, world's largest jet engine, has completed its first test flight in the US.
- Formidable Supersonic Cruise Missile **BrahMos** successfully flight tested from **Pokhran** test range in **Rajasthan**.
- Indian Navy's indigenously built warship INS Ganga (F22) was decommissioned in Mumbai, Maharashtra after over three decades of service.

 - As part of it, Chief Minister **Naveen Patnaik** flagged off **mobile video vans** that will move across the state to highlight various welfare schemes at villages in the state.
- The government has sanctioned **Rs.1,000 crore** for the phase two of the **IMPRINT India programme**.
 - Projects will cover domains like **defence**, **information technology**, and **energy**.
 - IMPRINT Impacting Research Innovation and Technology
- Union Minister Ananthkumar launched 100% Oxobiodegradable Sanitary Napkin, 'Suvidha', under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP).
 - The affordable sanitary napkin will be available for Rs. 2.50 per padat over 3200 Janaushadhi Kendras across India and would ensure 'Swachhta, Swasthya and Suvidha' for the underprivileged Women of India.
- On the International Women's Day (8th March 2018), the Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Shivraj Singh Chouhan announced the 'Mukhyamantri Mahila Kosh' scheme aimed at providing pension to unmarried women aged over 50 years.
 - Earlier, Chouhan announced **Rs.4,000** monthly assistance to **pregnant laborers** from the **sixth month** of **pregnancy**.
- The National Institution for Transforming India (NITI) Aayog has launched Women Entrepreneurship Platform (WEP) on the occasion of International Women's day (March 8, 2018).
 - WEP's theme song **'Naari Shakti'** composed and sung by renowned singer **Kailash Kher** was also released.
- The **Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises** launched **Udyam Sakhi Portal** (www.udyamsakhi.org) for women entrepreneurs on the occasion of International Women's Day.
 - The portal is a network for nurturing entrepreneurship and creating **business models** for low cost products and services in order to empower women and make them self-reliant and self-sufficient.
- The government of **Telangana** launched **Women Entrepreneurship Hub** (WE-Hub), India's first state-led incubator for women entrepreneurs.
 - The incubator will help women entrepreneurs establish their **own enterprises** by providing services including seed funding, mentoring, and business guidance.
 - Chief Executive Officer of WE-Hub: Deepthi Ravula

- PM Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for the Navi Mumbai international airport, which is expected to ease flight operations at Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport.
- President **Ram Nath Kovind** has released **Rs.1000** and **Rs.10** commemorative **coins** on the occasion of **Nabakalebar festival** at a function held in **Puri**, **Odisha**.
 - These coins were release to mark the festival which is a symbolic recreation of sibling deities –
 Lord Jagannath, Balabhadra and Devi Subhadra.
- The Union Cabinet approved the Ayushman Bharat National Health Protection Mission.
 Aim: To provide an annual health cover of Rs.5 lakh to 10 crore poor families.
- According to Union Budget, this is 'world's largest health protection scheme'.
 The Centre will fund 60% expenditure incurred by the scheme.
- To promote employment in **North Eastern Region states** including **Sikkim**, the Union Cabinet has approved **North East Industrial Development Scheme** (NEIDS), 2017.

 - It will be world's third largest trade bloc after European Union (EU) and North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA).

 - Apart from the above agreements, Companies from India and France signed contracts worth over 1 lakh crore on the first day of French President Emmanuel Macron's visit.

 - The new work week will consist of 40 regular hours and an additional **12 hours of overtime**.
- To deal with those banking fraudsters who are escaping overseas to avoid getting caught, the Union Cabinet proved the **Fugitive Economic Offenders Bill**.
- **Rajasthan** has become the **2nd Indian state** to pass a bill awarding **death penalty** to those convicted of **raping girls** aged **up to 12 years**.

- Last year, **Madhya Pradesh** enacted a law to award death sentence to those guilty of raping girls aged 12 years or below.
- The **Haryana** government approved a bill awarding **Death penalty** to those convicted of **raping** children under the age of **12 years**.
- Arunachal Pradesh Assembly has passed Arunachal Pradesh Land Settlement and Records Amendment Bill, 2018.
 - This bill will allow the state's **tribal people** to have ownership rights over **their land** for the first time.
- The Parliament passed the **Payment of Gratuity** (Amendment) **Bill** which will increase the ceiling of **tax-free gratuity** amount to **Rs.20 lakh** from **Rs.10 lakh**.
- The **Telangana** Assembly passed a bill making the **teaching of Telugu** language in schools **compulsory**.
 - According to the **Telangana (Compulsory Teaching and Learning of Telugu in Schools) Act**, the language will be a mandatory subject for **Classes 1-10** from the upcoming academic session.
- To tackle organized crime with strict punishment, the **Uttar Pradesh** Assembly passed the **Uttar Pradesh Control of Organized Crime Act** (UPCOCA) **2017 bill**.

Fund

- The Centre approved projects worth over **Rs.2,900 crore** under the **Nirbhaya fund** for **eight** major **cities** of the country in a bid to make them **safer for women**.
 - Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad Ahmedabad and Lucknow have been sanctioned a total of Rs.2,919.55 crore after a meeting of the Empowered Committee, which is headed by the secretary of Women and Child Development (WCD).
- China has announced that it will spend **\$175 billion** on **Defence** this year. This is nearly **4 times** as compared to **India's** \$45- billion defence budget.
- Union Minister **CR Chaudhary** revealed that the **Foreign Direct Investment** (FDI) of **\$209 billion** has been received during April 2014 to December 2017 period.
 - The sectors that received **maximum inflows** include services, computer software and hardware, construction, telecom, automobile, and trading.
 - He further revealed that functional **Export Oriented Units** have reduced to 2,197 from 2,239 in 2016-17.
- The **Indian** government plans to **borrow Rs.2.88 lakh crore** between April-September in the upcoming fiscal.
 - This amounts to **47.5% of government's budgeted** gross **borrowing target** for the financial year.
- The **Euro zone** has approved a **€6.7-billion loan** to **Greece** under the third bailout deal, with €5.7 billion.
- **Hong Kong** is going to pay **2.8 million citizens** a cash handout of up to HK\$4,000 (over 33,000) amid reports of a **Rs.1-lakh crore surplus** in its annual budget.

Economy

- Madhya Pradesh Finance Minister Jayant Kumar Malaiya presented the state budget worth over Rs.2 lakh crore with focus on agriculture, health, education, and employment.
 - The budget allocated **Rs.37,000 crore** for the **agriculture** sector.
- Telangana finance minister Etela Rajender presented the state budget 2018-19 of Rs 1,74,453 crore.
- India's **Gross Domestic Product** (GDP) growth surged to **7.2**% in the December quarter of 2017-18, restoring its status as the world's fastest-growing major economy.
 - The economy grew at **6.7**% in **Gross Value Added** (GVA) terms.

- The GDP growth rebounded from **6.5**% in the **previous** quarter, reportedly indicating that the economy has moved past disruptions due to demonetisation and GST rollout.
- **Marshall Islands** in Pacific Ocean is set to become **1st country** in **world** to recognize **Cryptocurrency** as its **legal tender** and adopt transparent crypto monetary system.
 - The parliament of island has passed law to create the digital currency called "**Sovereign**" with symbol **SOV** to raise some hard cash to pay bills and boost economy.
- Andhra Pradesh finance minister Yanamala Ramakrishnudu presented Rs 1.91-lakh-crore budget, and projected a revenue surplus of **Rs.5,235 crore**, for the financial year 2018-19.
- The World Bank has said **India's highest GST rate** of **28**% is the 2nd highest among a sample of 115 countries which have a similar indirect tax system.
 - Only **five** countries, including India, use four **non-zero GST slabs**.
- Investment bank **Goldman Sachs** has downgraded its forecast for the Indian economy in the wake of the alleged **\$2-billion PNB fraud**.
 - It lowered its real GDP forecast on India for 2018-19 to **7.6% from 8%** earlier.
- Meeting for the first time under **Chairman Jerome Powell**, the **US Federal Reserve officials**, raised the interest rate by 25 bps to a range of **1.5**% **to 1.75**%.
- Arvind Kejriwal-led Delhi government presented its 1st "green budget" in the assembly, with an emphasis on education, health and environment.
 - Out of the total Rs.53,000 cr budget, Rs.13,999 crore has been allocated for education sector in the state.
- Venezuelan President Nicolás Maduro announced to re-denominate the country's bolívar currency by knocking three zeroes off, effective from June 4 this year.

- Technology giant **Google** has launched **Hangouts Chat**, a messaging service for the **workplace**.
 - It features virtual rooms for different parts of a company's team with a capacity to hold up to 8,000 users per room and works with 28 different languages.
- The third-largest manufacturer of flash memory **SanDisk** has unveiled the **world's fastest microSD** card called **Extreme UHS-I microSDXC** with **400 GB** of storage.
 - The card can achieve **read speeds** of up to **160 Mbps** and **write speeds** of up to **90 Mbps**.
- **Indian** e-payments and e-commerce brand **Paytm** has emerged as the **largest contributor** to the overall volume of **UPI transactions** in **February 2018**.
- **Facebook** is expanding its **Jobs feature** to **search** and apply for **jobs directly** on its platform to more than 40 countries including **India**.
- **Google** has unveiled a quantum processor with **72 qubits**, surpassing IBM's **50-qubit** computer unveiled last year.
- **Google** is going to **ban advertisements** promoting **Crypto-currencies** and related content including **initial coin offerings**, from **June** this year.
 - Earlier, social network **Facebook** also **banned** advertisements promoting crypto-currencies.
- E-commerce major Amazon has launched its 1st-ever debit card called 'Amazon Rechargeable' in Mexico.
- **Google** announced the integration of **Hindi language** in its **Assistant** for devices running **Android 6.0 Marshmallow** and above.
- Indian e-payments and e-commerce brand Paytm has launched two wealth management products under 'Paytm Gold', called 'Gold Gifting' and 'Gold Savings Plan'.

- Gold Gifting: With Gold Gifting, users will be able to send 24K 999.9 Purity gold to others digitally.
- Gold Savings Plan: This will let users save gold as per their requirement by entering the duration and amount of gold they want to save.
- **Google** has announced that users in the **US** will now be able to **send** or ask for **money** by using its • voice Assistant via Googles Payments App.
- WhatsApp has started testing payments through QR codes for selected users in its latest beta • updates.
 - Users can scan the code; enter the amount payable and **UPI PIN** for verification to send money.

Exports/Imports

- A report by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute has revealed that India was the largest weapons importer in the world over the last five years, accounting for 12% of the total global imports.
 - Russia was India's largest supplier, accounting for 62% of the imports.
 - With the imports of 57% **US** became **India's second** largest supplier.
- To protect domestic producers from below-cost shipments, the Indian government has imposed • anti-dumping duty on import of 'Ofloxacin' from China.

Taxation/Trade

- To help boost overseas sales in a year of surplus production, the Indian government has scrapped the 20% sugar export tax.
 - India is world's second-largest producer of sugar after Brazil.
- US President Donald Trump imposed \$60 billion (Rs 3.9 lakh crore) of tariffs on Chinese imports • to punish the country for its "unfair" seizure of American intellectual property, a move that could escalate the already tense trade relations between the world's two biggest economies.

Space

- Elon Musk-led SpaceX successfully launched its Falcon 9 rocket for the 50th time, carrying the 6,000 kg **Hispasat** satellite, the largest geostationary satellite the company has ever flown.
- The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) is inviting people around the world • to submit their **names online** to be placed on a **microchip aboard** its **Parker Solar Probe mission**, scheduled to launch in July this year.
- Russian President Vladimir Putin has claimed that the country would be launching an unmanned • mission to Mars in 2019.
- In an effort aimed at rebuilding the economy, **Greece** established the country's first space agency ٠ titled the Hellenic Space Organization.
- 56-year-old Mangala Mani has become ISRO's first woman scientist to spend 403 days in Antarctica.
- The Indian Space and Research Organisation (ISRO) has postponed launch of India's second ٠ lunar mission 'Chandrayaan-2' from April 2018 to October-November 2018 as experts have suggested more tests.
 - It will be launched on board of Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle Mk III (GSLV-F10).
- China's "out-of-control" space laboratory Tiangong-1 would crash into Earth between March 30 and April 2, according to the European Space Agency.

- The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) is going to launch the Transiting Exoplanet Survey Satellite (TESS) on April 16.
 - TESS is seen as a successor to the **Kepler Space Telescope** which has discovered over 2,500 exoplanets and is currently running out of fuel.
- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is going to launch communication satellite GSAT6A from Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC), Sriharikota.
 - GSAT-6A, similar to **GSAT-6** is useful in satellite-based mobile communication applications.

Science and Technology

- Wadhwani AI, India's first research institute dedicated to developing artificial intelligence solutions for social good was inaugurated in Mumbai.
- Cybersecurity agencies have detected a new malware called **Saposhi**, which can take over electronic devices and use them for **Distributed Denial of Service** (DDoS) attacks.
 - Saposhi Malware is capable of taking over electronic devices and turning them into **bots** (device taken over by malware) which can then be used for any purpose.
- Russian cybersecurity firm Kaspersky Lab's researchers have discovered a malware titled 'Slingshot' which spies on users' PCs via routers.
 - This malware can access data including keyboard strokes, network traffic, passwords, and screenshots.
- The Central Institute for Research on Buffaloes (CIRB) has claimed that India's first cloned Assamese buffalo male calf named Sach-Gaurav was born in Hisar, Haryana.
 - It was born to Murrah buffalo, at Hi Tech Sach Dairy Farm, 100 kms from cloning laboratory, making it first buffalo calf to be born in field.
- US-based company Nimbus Data has unveiled world's largest solid state drive (SSD) ExaDrive DC100 with 100 TB of storage.

Health/Diseases/Drugs

- The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare launched a new program titled LaQshya.
 - Aim: Improving quality of maternity care in labor room and maternity Operation Theatre (OT).

Energy/Gas/Oil

- The **world's largest solar park**, **Shakti Sthala**, was inaugurated in **Karnataka's Pavagada** by Karnataka CM **Siddaramaiah** and state Power Minister **DK Shivakumar**.
 - The park has a 2000-MW capacity and was built at a cost of **Rs.16500 crore**, over 13,000 acres across **five** villages.
- **Iraq** has overtaken **Saudi Arabia** to become **India's top crude oil supplier** by supplying 38.9 million tonnes (MT) crude oil in the current financial year.
- India for first time has started process of importing Liquid Natural Gas (LNG) from United States. The development comes on the heels of India's first import of crude oil from the US in October 2017.
- **Diu** has become the **1st** and only **Union Territory** in the country to be fully run on **solar energy**.
- The **Power Ministry** has directed all **Central government departments** and **PSUs** in the **National Capital Region** to switch to **e-vehicles** for local use.
- PM Narendra Modi and French President Emmanuel Macron pledged to begin work on "the largest nuclear power plant in the world" in India by this year.
 - Urging Electricite de France SA and India's Nuclear Power Corporation to accelerate discussions on a contract and start work at Maharashtra's Jaitapur, the leaders said the plant would have a 9.6-gigawatt capacity.

• Surat (Gujarat) has become the 1st Indian district to have 100% solar-powered Primary Health Centres (PHCs).

- The **World Wildlife Fund** for **Nature** is organizing the 12th annual '**Earth Hour**' on March 24 from 8:30 to 9:30 PM.
- The 45th anniversary of the **Chipko** movement was observed on March 26.
 - Although the Chipko Movement has its origins in the 18th century Rajasthan, it found momentum in the 1970s as a way to **protect forests**.
- China has announced that it had already met its **2020 carbon dioxide emissions reduction target** in 2017.
 - China cut CO2 emissions per unit of GDP by 46% from the 2005 level, fulfilling its commitment before 2020.

Education

- The **Rajasthan** government has decided to **introduce uniforms** for **college students**.
- The Union Textile Ministry has approved a proposal for setting up a Garment university in Bangalore's Bommanahalli.


