RESERVE BANK OF INDIA

- To focus on creating awareness among customers of banks, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is conducting **Financial Literacy Week**, which was started from **4th June** to **8th June 2018**.
 - Theme of Financial Literacy Week: 'Customer Protection'.
- RBI hikes **Repo Rate** to **6.25 bps** after more than 4 years.
 - Reverse Repo Rate 6 per cent.
 - Bank rate 6.50 per cent
 - Growth projection retained at 7.4 pc
 - Retail inflation at **4.8-4.9 pc** for April-September

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to allow voluntary transition of **Urban Cooperative Banks** meeting certain prescribed criteria into **Small Finance Banks**.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced that it will set up a **Public Credit Registry** (PCR) as a repository of information regarding **loan information of individuals** and **corporate borrowers**.
 - This decision has been taken as per recommendations of Y. M. Deosthalee committee.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has made changes in the **Gold Monetization Scheme** (GMS) 2015 to enable people to open a **hassle-free gold deposit account**.
- On the backdrop of rising oil prices and shortfall in **FPI inflows** to the country the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is expected to **raise \$30-35 billion** via NRI bonds to raise the rupee.
- Concerned over **funds sent abroad** under the **'Maintenance of Close Relative'** category of the **Liberalized Remittance Scheme (LRS)**, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has narrowed the definition of relatives to check the flow of funds.
 - Hence, funds under the 'maintenance of close relative' category can be sent only to immediate relatives such as parents, spouses, children and their spouses.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has revised the **Priority Sector Lending** (PSL) guidelines for housing loans with **Affordable Housing** definition under the **Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana**.
 - The apex bank announced that housing loans of up to 35 lakh rupees for dwellings costing less than 45 lakh rupees, will be treated as priority sector lending to give a fillip to the low-cost segment.
 - The RBI has further revised existing family income limit of Rs.2 lakh per annum for loans to housing projects for Economically Weaker Sections and Low Income Groups to Rs 3 lakh per annum and Rs.6 lakh per annum, respectively.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has proposed setting up of Board of Management (BoM) in all Urban Co-operative Banks (UCBs) having deposits of over Rs.100 crore within one year to strengthen governance and promote professional management in these banks.
- **Public Sector Banks (PSBs)** accounted for over **85% of total fraud cases** reported in the banking system in 2017-18, a recently released RBI report revealed.

STATE BANK OF INDIA

- The **State Bank of India (SBI)** has informed refiners that it **won't handle payments for crude oil** from **Iran** from November.
 - This comes after US President Donald Trump pulled out of Iran nuclear deal and pledged to impose "highest level of sanctions" within 180 days.
 - This move affects India's imports of Iranian oil from August-end.
- India's largest lender **State Bank of India (SBI)** is in the process of **closing** down **9 foreign branches** as part of rationalization of overseas operations.

OTHER BANKS

- **Public Sector Banks** collectively suffered a net loss of **Rs.87,357 crore** in 2017-18.
 - Punjab National Bank (PNB) posted the highest loss of nearly Rs.12,283 crore.
- At least **five** major banks including **ICICI Bank** and **Axis Bank** are testing the system to send banking communications through **WhatsApp**.
- Union Cabinet has approved the proposal for grant of permission to **HDFC Bank** to raise additional share **capital** of up to a maximum of 24,000 crore rupees.
- Facebook-owned messaging service WhatsApp has started the mass rollout of WhatsApp Payments feature via UPI platform in India.

- State-owned **Bank of Baroda** along with **Indian Overseas Bank** and **Andhra Bank** are in advanced discussions with a possible buyer to sell their stake in Malaysian joint venture **India International Bank (Malaysia) Berhad**.
 - Bank of Baroda holds a 40 per cent stake in India International Bank (Malaysia), while Indian Overseas Bank and Andhra Bank own 35 per cent and 25 per cent stake, respectively.
- **Public sector banks** have written off bad loans worth **Rs.1.20 lakh crore**, an amount that is nearly one-and-a-half times more than their total losses posted in 2017-18.
- The **Banks Board Bureau (BBB)** has recommended 22 general managers to be elevated as Executive Directors at the various **Public Sector Banks (PSBs)**.
 - The Appointments Committee of Cabinet (ACC) headed by **Prime Minister** will take the final decision in this regard and will release the names.
- India's fourth largest private sector bank, Yes Bank announced that it has received approval from
 market regulator Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for acting as custodian of
 securities.
- Private sector lender **Karnataka Bank** is targeting to disburse about **Rs.9000 crore agriculture loan** this fiscal, seeing potential opportunities in the sector.
 - The bank has announced that it is also in line with government's vision to double farm sector income by 2022.
- State-run **Punjab National Bank (PNB)** has set up **loan recovery cells** in all its 6,900 branches.
- The **UK's Financial Conduct Authority** has fined state-owned **Canara Bank's UK** division £896,100 (**Rs.**8 crore) for breaching **anti-money laundering laws**.
 - It has also prohibited the bank from accepting new deposits for nearly five months.
- The **Bank of Maharashtra** board stripped the bank's MD and CEO **Ravindra Marathe** and Executive Director **RK Gupta** of all functional responsibilities with immediate effect.
 - This comes after Marathe and Gupta were arrested in the Rs.2043-crore DSK Group loan fraud case.
 - The other executive director A C Rout has been given the charge of the bank's CEO.

INSURANCE

- The Odisha government has launched Gopabandhu Sambadika Swasthya Bima Yojana, a new Healt Insurance scheme for Journalists.
 - This scheme provides Rs.2 Lakh per annum health insurance cover to all working journalists of the state.
- The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority (IRDAI) has approved Life Insurance Corporation (LIC)'s plan to buy 51 per cent stake in IDBI Bank as the insurance regulator gave the insurer exemption from 15 per cent investment cap.
 - The LIC is expected to invest around Rs.13000 crore in tranches in the NPA-mired state-run lender.

SUPREME COURT

• Following directions from Supreme Court, the **Central** Government has constituted the **Cauvery Water Management Authority** (CMA) to address the dispute over sharing of river water among **Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala** and **Puducherry**.

HIGH COURTS AND SESSIONS COURTS

• The **Bombay High Court** recently approved the **service of notice** about litigation in a **PDF format** through **WhatsApp** as valid.

- The **UK High Court** has ordered embattled liquor tycoon **Vijay Mallya** to pay a minimum of 2 lakh pounds towards the costs incurred by 13 Indian banks in their legal battle to recover alleged dues.
- The **Uttarakhand High Court** has **banned water sports** in the state until the government frames a policy to **regulate** them.
- The **Uttarakhand** High Court has ordered the state government to set the **limit of loudspeakers** at **5 decibels**.

ELECTION COMMISSION

- The **Uttar Pradesh** government has prepared a **report** to implement **One Nation One Election formula** in the state.
 - The Committee has suggested that the formula can be implemented in **two phases**.

CENTRAL GOVERNMENT

- Centre has approved construction of **one lakh fifty thousand houses** for **urban poor** under the **Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana**.
- Uttar Pradesh's Mughal Sarai Junction has officially been renamed as Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Junction, after President Ram Nath Kovind gave his assent to the state government's proposal.
- The government has made **Permanent Account Number** (PAN) **mandatory** for **sending** money **abroad** under the **Liberalized Remittance Scheme** (LRS).
- The government has opened **10 joint secretary-level posts** for **private sector employees**, who neither require to be an **IAS officer** nor **UPSC qualified** to be eligible for the job.
- Indian Parliament's Monsoon Session will be held from July 18 to August 10.
- Following the recommendation of the **7th Pay Commission**, the Centre has decided to **stop** giving **overtime allowance** to most employees, excluding operational staff.
- **India** would start getting data on deposits made by **Indians** this year in **Swiss Banks** as part of a bilateral treaty signed between the two nations, interim Finance Minister Piyush Goyal announced.

STATES

- The **Andhra Pradesh** government has announced a first of its kind **monthly allowance** of **Rs.1,000** each to **unemployed graduate youths** in the state with an **upper age limit of 35**.
- The state of **Telangana** was celebrating the 4th anniversary of its foundation on June 2.
- On the World Environment Day, **Tamil Nadu** CM **Edappadi K Palaniswami** announced that the state would **ban** the use of **plastic** from **2019**.
 - Milk and oil pouches, along with other basic need items will be exempted from the ban.
- Ahead of the World Environment Day, the Haryana CM Manohar Lal Khattar has banned singleuse water bottles in all government offices in the state and ordered the use of only multi-use water bottles.
- The **Uttarakhand Chief Minister Trivendra Singh Rawat** announced a blanket (complete) **ban** on **polythene** starting **July 31**.
- In a bid to check **e-waste problem**, **Rajasthan** government has launched a scheme wherein people can sell their **old phones**, **computers**, **routers** and any other electronic items to the **government**.
- President Ram Nath Kovind has declared the Queen Variety pineapple as state fruit of Tripura.
- Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has declared the state open-defecation free after achieving the goal of constructing 2.77 lakh individual toilets.

- Andhra Pradesh is set to become 1st state in India to use Auto-Disable Syringes for all clinical purposes to prevent infection.
 - The state will enforce this decision from will from the **World Hepatitis Day** (28th July).
- Haryana CM Manohar Lal Khattar has deferred the government notification which directed sportspersons employed with the state to pay 33% of their income to the sports council.
- The **Bihar** government is planning to **ban Khaini** (chewing tobacco), on health grounds.
- **Kerala** Government has decided to **lift high alert issued** in the wake of outbreak of deadly **Nipah virus** in May 2018 in northern Kozhikode and Malappuram districts of state that has so far claimed 17 lives.
- The **Haryana** government has raised the **upper age limit** of entry into **government service** from 40 to **42 years**.
- The **Kerala** government has announced plans to launch the **Comprehensive Newborn Screening programme** to detect birth defects in babies born in government health facilities within 48 hours of birth.
- The **Telangana** government directed all urban local bodies and civic municipal bodies to **ban** usage of **single-use plastic** in the **offices**.
- **Tamil Nadu** is going to **ban electronic cigarettes**, battery-operated inhalers that emit doses of vaporized nicotine.
- **Rajasthan** Governor **Kalyan Singh** has discontinued the tradition of giving ceremonial Guard of Honor to the **Governor**.
 - With this he became the first Governor of the country who made big changes regarding this type of arrangements.
- The **Haryana government** has decided to introduce an **environment-centric scheme**, under which **school children** will be given **Rs.50** for **planting trees** every **six months** for a period of **three years**.
- **Shillong** (Capital city of Meghalaya) has been selected as **100th Smart City**, to receive funding under the Centre's flagship **Smart Cities Mission**, after evaluating the proposal submitted by it.
- **Richard Branson**-led **Virgin Hyperloop One** is going to invest **Rs.3000 crore** to build a 15-km-long Hyperloop demonstration track in Pune for the **Mumbai-Pune Hyperloop project**.
- The **ban on plastic** came into effect from across the state of **Maharashtra**.
 - The fine for the first-time and second-time offence will be **Rs.5000** and **Rs.10000** respectively, while a third violation would attract **Rs.25000**-fine and three-month jail.
- **Haryana** has made use of **LED bulbs** and **tubelights** mandatory in all government offices by August 15.
- **Maharashtra** has become the 18th state to enforce a complete **ban** on the sale, use and manufacture of **plastic** bags.
 - Other states which have imposed a complete ban include Rajasthan, Jammu & Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, among others.
- **Jammu and Kashmir** Governor **N N Vohra** made **biometric attendance** compulsory in all state government offices with immediate effect.
- The **Gujarat** government has launched a new **solar power scheme** for **farmers** titled **Suryashakti Kisan Yojana** (SKY).
- On the occasion of International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, the **Karnataka** government has announced a new toll-free number **1908** to **report drug activity**.

PERSONALITIES

- A 22-year-old **Sikh** soldier **Guardsman Charanpreet Singh Lall** created history by becoming the 1st to wear a **turban** instead of a **bearskin hat** during the **Trooping the Color parade** (an annual parade that marks the birthday of Britain's longest-reigning monarch Queen Elizabeth II).
- American politician who served as the 41st President of the United States, George HW Bush turned 94.
 - With this, he officially became the longest living President in US history.
- **Goa** Chief Minister **Manohar Parrikar** returned to **India** after he spent two and a half months in the **US**, where he was receiving treatment for a pancreatic ailment.
- National Statistics Day commemorates the birth anniversary of Indian Bengali scientist and applied statistician, **Prof. Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis**.

DEFENCE AND NATIONAL SECURITY

- World's largest international maritime warfare exercise, RIMPAC (Rim of the Pacific Exercise) was held from 27th June 2018 to 2nd August 2018.
- **India** has decided to go ahead with acquiring the **S-400 antiaircraft missile system** from **Russia** despite the US warning against the procurement.
 - The Rs.40,000-crore deal will be announced during a summit between PM Narendra Modi and President Vladimir Putin in October.
- **India** successfully test-fired the indigenously developed and nuclear-capable Long Range Ballistic Missile **Agni 5**.
- Landlocked nation **Ethiopia** is going to build a **new Navy** as part of military reforms.
- Indian Naval Ship (INS) Sunayana successfully completed the Operation NISTAR, which was
 initiated to rescue 38 Indian Nationals from cyclone-hit Socotra Island in Yemen under swift
 Humanitarian and Disaster Relief Operation (HADR).
- Malabar 2018, a trilateral naval exercise involving the United States, Japan and India began off the coast of Guam in the Phillipine Sea.
 - The exercise is divided into two phases. Harbor phase Sea phase.
 - This is the 1st joint exercise after the US renamed its Hawaii-based Pacific command as the Indo-Pacific Command.
- India's 1st indigenous, long-range artillery gun 'Dhanush' has cleared its final test at Pokhran, Rajasthan and is ready to be inducted into the Indian Army.
- India is going to host 1st military exercise of the BIMSTEC Countries 2018.
 - The exercise is scheduled to be held in **Pune** (Maharashtra) in the second week of September.
 - Aim: To promote strategic alignment among the member-states and to share best practices in the area of counter-terrorism.
 - BIMSTEC: Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation
- The 13th edition of **India-Nepal** joint military exercise '**Surya Kiran**' successfully concluded at Pithoragarh, **Uttarakhand**.
- The **US government** has approved a deal to sell **six AH-64E Apache attack helicopters** to **India** for \$930 million.
- The **Indian Army** has started an initiative titled '**Kashmir Super 30 Medical**', which is a full-time coaching project for **NEET aspirants** in **Jammu and Kashmir**.
 - This comes after the success of 'Kashmir Super-40', a similar initiative for engineering in which 28 out of 40 students cracked the IIT-JEE Mains 2017.
- Defence Minister **Nirmala Sitharaman** inaugurated the 1st office of leading defence PSU **Bharat Electronics Limited** in **Hanoi**, reflecting India's deepening military cooperation with **Vietnam**.

- The Indian Coast Guard (ICG) has commissioned Fast Patrol Vessel (FPV) ICGS Rani Rashmoni, in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.
 - It is 5th and last ship to be commissioned in the series of Fast Patrol Vessel (FPV) project of ICG.
- India and Bangladesh have agreed to institute Coordinated Patrol (CORPAT) as an annual exercise between navies of two neighboring countries.
 - The first edition of CORPAT was inaugurated by Indian Navy's Chief Admiral Sunil Lanba during his visit to Bangladesh.
- Aiming to take the defence ties to a newer height, External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj handed over the second Dornier maritime reconnaissance aircraft to visiting President of Seychelles Danny Faure.

 - Aim To inspire more and more people to plant maximum saplings during current monsoon season so as to save environment from pollution hazards.
- Spiritual guru **Sri Sri Ravishankar's** consumer goods venture **Sri Sri Tattva** has launched an inhouse apparel brand **BYOGI**.
 - BYOGI will have ranges of ethnic wears, yoga wears and yoga accessories like mats.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of Vanijya Bhawan at Delhi's Akbar road.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the Mohanpura irrigation project in Madhya Pradesh's Rajgarh district.

- The 2-day **Conference of Governors** and **Lt. Governors** commenced at Rashtrapati Bhavan with the inaugural address of President **Ram Nath Kovind**.
- The 18th **Shanghai Corporation Organization** (SCO) **summit** concluded on 10th June at **Qingdao**, **China** with the adoption of the Qingdao declaration.
- **Island** nation **Mauritius** is going to host the **11th World Hindi Conference** in its capital city **Port Lois** from 18th to 20th August 2018.
 - Theme: "Vaishvik Hindi Aur Bharatiy Sanskriti".
- The summit between the **United States** and **North Korea** finally took place in **Singapore**.
 - US President **Donald Trump** and North Korean leader **Kim Jong Un** met at a resort island of **Sentosa** along with their respective translators.
 - Both leaders signed a "comprehensive" document at the end of their historic summit, vowing to forge a new partnership and reverse decades of American policy toward the rogue regime.
- Russian President Vladimir Putin has invited North Korean leader Kim Jong-un to attend the Eastern Economic Forum which is scheduled to be held in September 2018 at Russia.
- Following the informal summit between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chinese President Xi
 Jinping, the Chinese envoy to India Luo Zhaohui unveiled a 4-point vision for future cooperation
 with India.
- For the first time, **US** President **Donald Trump** and **Russian** President **Vladimir Putin** are going to hold a bilateral summit at **Helsinki** (Finland's capital) on 16th July 2018.

- 8 states and 4 Union Territories have signed MoUs with the Union Health Ministry to implement the government's ambitious scheme Ayushman Bharat National Health Protection Mission.
 - Aim: To provide a cover of five lakh rupees per family annually to ten crore vulnerable families.
- The Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR) lab has signed Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with RAASI Solar Power Pvt Ltd for transfer of technology for India's first Lithium Ion (Li-ion) Battery project.
 - The agreement was signed by CSIR's Central Electro Chemical Research Institute (CECRI), Karaikudi, Tamil Nadu.
- Union Cabinet approved Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), India and Institut National de la Santeet de la RechercheMedicale (INSERM), France.

- **India** and the **United States** have pledged to continue their strong bilateral strategic partnership, after a meeting between Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** and US Defence Secretary **Jim Mattis**.
 - Both leaders met on the sidelines of the Shangri-La Dialogue in Singapore.
- Syrian President Bashar al-Assad is going to visit North Korean leader Kim Jong-un.
- External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj was visited to South Africa for a 5 day visit.
- The informal meeting of **IBSA Foreign Ministers** was recently held at **Pretoria**, **South Africa**.
 - IBSA India, Brazil, South Africa
- **Japanese** conglomerate **SoftBank's** CEO **Masayoshi Son** will meet Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** during his visit to **India**.
- 11th edition of Geo-Intelligence Asia 2018 was held at Manekshaw Centre in New Delhi.
 - The event was organized by Geo-Spatial Media and Communication with Directorate General of Information System as Knowledge Partners and Military Survey as Coorganizers.
 - **Aim**: To provide platform to showcase innovative applications of Geospatial technologies.
 - Theme: 'GeoSpatial: A Force Multiplier for Defense and Internal Security'.

 - During this visit, he signed several bilateral deals with China, including a MOU, according to which, China will build a railway connecting the western region of **Tibet with Nepal**.

BILLS THE CHENNAI SCHOOL OF BANKING

- **Uganda** passed a bill for "**social media tax**" imposing a **daily fee** of about **200 shillings** (Rs.3.57) for using platforms like **WhatsApp**, **Facebook**, **and Twitter**.
- Indian Health Ministry notified the Mental Healthcare Act 2017.
 - As per this act, Attempting suicide is no more a crime in India and there will be no more electric shocks for mentally ill children.
- The **Union Cabinet** has approved the proposal for introduction of **Dam Safety Bill, 2018** in the Parliament.
 - This bill aims to help all States and Union Territories to adopt uniform dam safety procedures which will ensure safety of dams and safeguard benefits from such dams.
- The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has banned Al Qaeda in Indian Subcontinent (AQIS) and Islamic State in Khorasan Province (ISKP) under anti-terror law, Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA), 1967.
 - **AQIS** is an affiliate of al Qaeda and **ISKP** is Afghanistan wing of Islamic State (IS).
- The Upper House of the **Dutch Parliament** passed a law **banning full-face veils** such as the burqa and niqab in public places.
- The **UK's Queen Elizabeth II** gave royal assent to the **Brexit bill** that would allow the country to leave the European Union (EU).
- The Centre announced a total overhaul of the **University Grants Commission Act** and a new legislation to set up the **Higher Education Commission of India (HECI)**.

FUND

- Malaysia has set up a trust fund for the public titled Malaysia Hope Fund, to donate money to help the government repay the country's debt.
 - Malaysia's national debt amounts to **\$250.8 billion** which is 80% of its GDP.
- The government has announced a comprehensive package of more than **Rs.8,000 crore** to provide relief to **sugarcane farmers** and to clear their dues, which have crossed over **Rs.22,000 crore**.
- To address the criticality of **ground water resources** in a major part of the country, the Indian government has formulated a new scheme titled, **Atal Bhujal Yojana**.
 - World Bank has approved six thousand crore rupees for this scheme.
- To facilitate **infrastructure investments** by **insurance and pension funds**, the Union Government is going to launch Rs.500 crore **Credit Enhancement Fund (CEF)** in July 2018.
- India extended financial aid of Rs. 99 million to Nepal for the construction of 2,700 Shallow Tube Well (STWs) irrigation systems in 12 districts of southern Terai region to boost agricultural productivity.
 - The assistance was extended as part of final payment for Nepal-Bharat Maitri Irrigation Project.
- **Japanese** conglomerate **SoftBank** is going to invest up to **\$100 billion** in **solar power generation** project in **India**.
- The **SAARC Development Fund (SDF)** is going to launch a **S**ocial Enterprise **D**evelopment **P**rogramme (SEDP) as part of its social window.
 - It intends to fund around 80 enterprises across the 8 SAARC member states (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka) annually.
- China led multilateral development bank, Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) has approved investment of \$200 million in India's National Investment & Infrastructure Fund (NIIF) to give greater impetus to mega infrastructure projects.
- With the total project portfolios of **US\$4.4 Billion**, **India** has been the largest borrower of **Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank** (**AIIB**) lending since the time the Bank started its operations.
- **India** announced to increase its grant to **Global Environment Facility's (GEF)** new four-year investment cycle, known as **GEF-7** from \$12 million to \$15 million.
 - India has pledged \$5 million for United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestinian Refugees (UNRWA) in the Near East.
 - Besides India, 19 countries also made pledges (contributions) for UNRWA at the Pledging Conference for UNRWA held in New York, US.

ECONOMY

- The **Foreign direct investment** (FDI) in **India** increased to **US \$61.96 billion** in 2017-18.
- **Senegal**-born singer **Akon** has announced the launch of his cryptocurrency called **AKoin** that will be available for sale in two weeks.
 - As part of the AKoin venture, the singer plans to complete a '100% crypto-based futuristic city' on 2,000 acres of land located near **Dakar**, the capital city of Senegal.
- The **Rupee** has hit an all-time low of **69.10** against **US dollar**.
 - This comes after spike in crude oil prices and concerns of higher inflation and widening current account deficit.
 - The previous record low for Rupee was 68.86 on November 24, 2016.
- The government has **met** its revised **fiscal deficit target** for 2017-18 at **3.53**% of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP).
 - The revenue deficit during fiscal 2017-18 was **4.43 trillion** or **101**% of the Budget estimate.

COMPANIES/INDUSTRY

- American multinational technology company Microsoft has launched the prototype of an underwater data centre off the coast of Scotland's Orkney Islands.
- Tata Power announced that it has bagged the contract for setting up a 150-MW solar project in Maharashtra.
- American multinational mass media and entertainment conglomerate Time Warner has been renamed as WarnerMedia, a day after AT&T completed its \$85.4 billion acquisition of the media conglomerate.
- India's IT major Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) became 1st listed company in India to close day's trade with Market Capitalization (m cap) of over Rs. 7 lakhs crore (over \$103 billion).
- Technology giant **Google** is planning to launch its **e-commerce platform** in the Indian market later this year.
 - Google's Vice President of Product Management Caesar Sengupta is likely to head the ecommerce unit for the company in India.
- Mukesh Ambani's **Reliance** is going to launch its **e-commerce business** by end of this year through an app meant for local retailers and stores.

EXPORTS/IMPORTS

India has raised import duties on almost 30 items including agricultural and steel products in protest against the US imposing higher levies on products shipped from the country.

TAXATION/TRADE

- The government clarified that the GST will not be applicable to free banking services such as cheque book issuance and ATM withdrawals.
 - However, interest charged on outstanding credit card bills, and exit fee paid by investors of mutual funds will be taxable under GST.

SPACE

- ACE
 The Centre approved the continuation of the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle and Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle Mark-III programmes, costing over Rs.10,000 crore.
- For the 1st time, Scientists of Physical Research Laboratory (PRL), Ahmedabad have discovered a distant planet revolving around Sun-like star and named both the planet and the star as EPIC.
- Russia has successfully launched Glonass-M positioning satellite on board of Soyuz-2.1b carrier rocket from the Plesetsk space centre in Mirny, Arkhangelsk Oblast.
- Russian billionaire and scientist Igor Ashurbeyli officially declared himself as the leader of the world's first space nation 'Asgardia'.
 - Asgardia aims to be an independent space nation, with its own government, currency, justice system and calendar.
- The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) is aiming to make India the first nation to land a rover near Moon's South Pole and study the potential for mining waste-free nuclear fuel that could be worth trillions of dollars.
 - ISRO will launch Chandrayaan-2 in October to analyze crust samples for signs of helium-3, which could meet global energy demands for 250 years if harnessed from Moon.
- The International Space Station (ISS) has launched a spacecraft titled RemoveDEBRIS, which would help remove human mission-threatening space debris including defunct satellites and used rockets.
- Four Chennai based engineering students have developed the world's lightest satellite which will be launched from a NASA facility in the US by August 2018.

The students built the 4cm 'cube' satellite 'Jaihind-1S' with a 3D printed outer casing from polylactic acid (PLA) nylon material, making it lighter than a medium sized egg, at just 33.39 grams.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

- Researchers at **Massachusetts Institute of Technology** (MIT) have developed an **artificial intelligence** (AI) tool called **Norman** which they claim is the world's first 'psychopathic' AI.
- Union Culture and Environment Minister **Mahesh Sharma** has announced that a scientific study called **Color Stereography** will be done on the **Taj Mahal** to determine its **exact color**.
- Researchers at **IISc Bangalore** have developed a '**LifeBox**' that can extend the preservation time of **organs**, specifically the **heart**, and allows for increased travel time and distances.
- The **United States** has unveiled the **world's most powerful supercomputer** titled '**Summit'**, beating the previous record holder **China's Sunway TaihuLight**.
 - With a peak performance of **200,000 trillion** calculations per second, 'Summit' is over twice as fast as Sunway TaihuLight, which is capable of 93,000 trillion calculations per second.
- The **Dutch city of Eindhoven** is set to be the 1st in the world to have habitable houses made by a **3D printer**.
- **University of Michigan** has regained the title of making the **world's smallest 'computer'** from **IBM** by making a device measuring **0.3mm x 0.3mm**, one-tenth of IBM's version.
- China's artificial intelligence major Baidu has tested its two driverless cars for the first time in Tianjin City, China.

HEALTH/DISEASES/DRUGS

- **US Food and Drug Administration** has approved the 1st **Prosthetic Iris** (colored part of the eye) that can be implanted to treat patients with **missing** or **damaged iris**.
- India has registered a significant decline in **Maternal Mortality Ratio** (MMR) recording a **22-per cent** reduction in such deaths since 2013.
- In its recently released International Classification of Diseases (ICD) 11, the World Health Organization (WHO) has classified Gaming addiction as mental health disorder.
 - The WHO also announced that being **Transgender** will no longer be classified as mental illness.
- Madhya Pradesh will be awarded under Prime Minister's Safe Motherhood Campaign for reducing maternal mortality.

ENERGY/GAS/OIL

- **India** received the first shipment of its so far cheapest **Liquefied Natural Gas** (LNG) from **Russian** supplier **Gazprom**.
 - The LNG has been delivered at a price close to USD 7 per million British Thermal Unit (mmBtu).
- Gujarat will become the 1st Indian state to get completely covered under the piped gas distribution network, once Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) completes bidding process for distributing natural gas in eight geographical areas (GAs) in Gujarat.
- **Mongolia** has launched construction of its 1st strategically important oil refinery funded by **India** in **southern Dornogovi province**.
 - This refinery was jointly launched by Mongolian Prime Minister Khurelsukh Ukhnaa and Indian Minister of Home Affairs Rajnath Singh.
- The Union Cabinet has approved establishment of additional 6.5 Million Metric Tonne (MMT) Strategic Petroleum Reserves (SPR) facilities at Chandikhol in Odisha and Padur in Karnataka.

ENVIRONMENT

According to the government think tank NITI Aayog's recent report, at least 21 major Indian cities, including Delhi and Bengaluru, are expected to run out of groundwater by 2020, affecting 100 million people.
