# Reserve Bank of India

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has issued a license to Bank of China to operate in India.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has announced that the license of **Alwar Urban Co-operative Bank** in Alwar, **Rajasthan** has been **cancelled** as it is not in a position to pay its depositors in full as and when their claims accrue, among other reasons.
- The **Finance Ministry** has conveyed to the **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) that it has no objection to allowing the **Tehran**-based **Bank Pasargad** to open its branch in **India**.
  - Apart from the Iranian Bank, branch license proposals of two South Korean banks, KEB Hana Bank and Kookmin Bank, have also been approved by the Centre.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** announced that it is going to issue new **Rs.100 denomination banknotes** in the Mahatma Gandhi (New) Series with **lavender** color.
  - The new denomination has the motif of Gujarat's archaeological site 'Rani ki vav' on the reverse, depicting the country's cultural heritage.
  - Dimension of the new banknote will be 66 mm × 142 mm.
- The **National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI)** has decided to **block transactions** made within the **same account** using **different UPI IDs**, effective August 1.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** cancelled the licenses of as many as 35 **Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs)**.
- **Commercial banks in India** will no longer be able to transact in **cryptocurrencies** like **Bitcoin** from in view of an **RBI directive** in April.

#### State Bank of India

- India's 2nd largest credit card issuer, SBI Card announced the launch of a virtual assistant for customer support and services titled 'ELA' (Electronic Live Assistant).
- India's largest lender **State Bank of India (SBI)**, **Punjab National Bank (PNB)** and **Bank of Baroda (BoB)** are planning to introduce a performance-linked salary structure for the senior management.
- India's largest lender **State Bank of India (SBI)** hiked its **Fixed Deposit (FD) interest rates** for select tenures.

#### Other Banks

- Indian banking and financial services company HDFC Bank has gone past Russia's Sberbank to become the most valuable bank in the emerging market outside China.
  - HDFC Bank's current market capitalization is \$78.4 billion against Sberbank's \$74.4 billion.
  - There are **four** lenders from India that now rank among the **world's 500 most valuable companies**.
  - HDFC Bank is followed by its housing finance cousin **Housing Development Finance Corporation** (HDFC), **Kotak Mahindra Bank** and **State Bank of India** (SBI).
- The government has approved **extension of recapitalization scheme** for **Regional Rural Banks** (**RRBs**) for next three years up to **2019-20** with an aim to strengthen their lending capacity.
  - "This will enable the RRBs to maintain the minimum prescribed capital to risk weighted assets ratio (CRAR) of 9 per cent," the Cabinet said in a statement.
- **India's** third largest private-sector bank **Axis Bank** announced it has recommended the names of **three** candidates for the **CEO's** post for approval of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
  - The candidate as approved by the RBI, will succeed Shikha Sharma, who's term as MD and CEO of the bank, is due to expire on December 31.
- NABARD was celebrating its 36th Foundation Day on July 12.
- Airtel Payments Bank received the requisite approvals from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to resume taking new customers.
- Andhra Bank has filed a bankruptcy petition against apparel retailer Provogue India at the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) for non-payment of dues.
  - A group of lenders led by Andhra Bank acquired a 51% stake in Provogue India by swapping debt into equity in 2016.
- The Finance Ministry approved infusion of Rs.11,336 crore in 5 state-owned lenders namely Punjab National Bank (PNB), Allahabad Bank, Corporation Bank, Andhra Bank and Indian Overseas Bank (IOB).
  - As per the approval, the Nirav Modi Scam hit Punjab National Bank (PNB) is going to get the highest amount of Rs 2,816 crore out, followed by Allahabad Bank, which is going to get Rs 1,790 crore.
  - Andhra Bank is going to get Rs.2019 crore, and Indian Overseas Bank will get Rs.2,157 crore followed by Corporation Bank Rs 2,555 crore.

#### Insurance

- The **Health Ministry** has clarified it's **not mandatory** for beneficiaries to submit **Aadhaar details** for seeking **Rs.**5-lakh **health insurance** under the **Ayushman Bharat scheme**, which is also known as '**Modicare**'.
- The board of **Life Insurance Corporation (LIC)** gave its approval to buy up to **51**% **stake** in public sector lender **IDBI Bank**.
  - LIC's stake buy will help the debt-ridden state-owned bank get a capital support of Rs.10000-13,000 crore.

# **Supreme Court**

- The **Supreme Court** upheld the **death penalty** for the convicts of the **2012 Nirbhaya gangrape case**, after hearing a review petition seeking reduction of sentence.
- The Supreme Court ordered that the **Third-party insurance** for a term of **three years** will be mandatory for **Cars** being sold from September 1.
  - The apex court also ruled that third-party insurance for a period of five years will be mandatory for two-wheelers.

## **High Courts and Sessions Courts**

- The **Uttarakhand** high court has declared the entire **Animal Kingdom**, including birds and aquatic animals, as a **legal entity** having rights of a "**living person**".
- Madras High Court has ruled that mentioning father's name in birth certificates is optional.

#### **Election Commission**

• The **Election Commission of India** has launched a mobile application titled "**cVIGIL**" to enable citizens to report any **violation of the Model Code of Conduct** (MCC) during **elections**.

## **Central Government**

- The government is celebrating July 1st as 'GST Day' as the indirect tax regime completes one year.
- The Centre approved the raise in **Minimum Support Price (MSP)** for **kharif crops** in line with its budget announcement to ensure that farmers get at least **1.5 times** of the production cost.
  - The MSP for **paddy** has been hiked to around **Rs.1,750** per quintal from previous year's Rs.1,550 and **corn** increased to **Rs.1,700** from Rs.1,131.
- The government has proposed to create a **special group** to keep a check on **e-commerce platforms** like Flipkart and Amazon India so that the foreign investment policy is not violated.
- The government indicated that **25**% of the **ATMs** run by state-owned banks may be **vulnerable** to fraud as they are running on **outdated software**.
- The Union Government has reduced minimum yearly deposit required under popular girl child savings scheme, **Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana** to **Rs 250** from **Rs 1,000** earlier.
  - In this regard, Government has amended **Sukanya Samriddhi Account Rules**, 2016.

#### States

- **Jharkhand** Chief Minister **Raghubar Das** announced that the first '**Khadi mall**' of India will be opened in the state soon.
- **Punjab** Chief Minister **Captain Amarinder Singh** announced that the government has decided to seek **Death Penalty** for **drug peddling and smuggling**.
- The **Rajasthan** government announced **1**% **reservations** for five communities- **Gujjar**, **Banjara**, **Gadia-Lohar**, **Raika**, **and Gadariya** under the **Most Backward Classes** (MBC) category.
- With an aim to improve **health of school children**, **Rajasthan** Chief Minister **Vasundhara Raje** launched a scheme titled '**Annapurna milk distribution scheme**' to **provide milk** to the students of class 1 to 8.
- **Delhi** CM **Arvind Kejriwal** along with the spiritual leader **Dalai Lama** launched a '**Happiness Curriculum**' for students studying in **Class Nursery to Class 8** in government schools.
- **Numaligarh Refinery Ltd (NRL)**, **Assam** has became first oil Public Sector Undertaking (PSU) in India to adopt an **online legal compliance system** by introducing '**Legatrix**'.
- Punjab Chief Minister Captain Amarinder Singh has ordered a mandatory dope test for all government employees, including police personnel, from the time of their recruitment through every stage of their service. Drug screening will be mandatory in cases of promotions, and also be a part of annual medical examinations.

- **Uttar Pradesh** Chief Minister **Yogi Adityanath** has announced a **ban on plastic in the state** effective **July 15**, days after **Maharashtra** announced a plastic ban from June 23.
- In a bid to cut costs incurred by the state government, the **West Bengal** chief minister **Mamata Banerjee** set a "one person one car" policy for ministers and bureaucrats and mandated economy class for all domestic air travel.
- The **Himachal Pradesh** government has banned the use and sale of **Thermocol Cutlery** including cups, plates, glasses, spoons or any other item in the state.
- The **Punjab government** has announced that it is going to provide **Rs.5 lakh** to every village that turns free of drugs to purchase sports and gym equipment for the youth.
- Gujarat Government has granted religious minority status to Jews living in the state.
  - With this, Gujarat becomes the **third** state in India to grant religious minority status to Jews after **West Bengal** and **Maharashtra**.
- Odisha government ordered a ban on the use of plastic bags and single-use plastic in the state starting from October 2.
  - The ban will be imposed in Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Rourkela, Berhampur and Sambalpur municipal corporations and Puri town in the first phase.
- Himachal Pradesh CM Jairam Thakur announced a Rs.1.55-crore project to set up a cow sanctuary at Kotla Barog.
- To reduce **air pollution** in the city, the **Delhi** Cabinet approved the engagement of 1,000 low-floor environment-friendly **electric buses**.
- Drawing inspiration from the highly-successful 'Amma' canteens in Tamil Nadu, the **Andhra Pradesh government** launched its own '**Anna' canteens** across the state.
- The Haryana government has announced that the individuals accused of Rape and Molestation
  will be barred from government services including losing their driving and arms licenses and oldage pension till their trial is completed.
- The **Uttarakhand** government has announced that it will make provisions for awarding **death penalty** to rapists of **minor girls**.
  - Currently, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, and Haryana have approved death penalty for rapists of girls aged up to 12.
- Maharashtra Food Supplies Minister Ravindra Chavan announced that people will be allowed to carry food items along with them in cinema halls and multiplexes in the state.
- In a first of its kind initiative, the **Madhya Pradesh** state govt. is going to appoint **Girls** as a **District Brand Ambassador** who has recorded significant achievements in any field under the **Beti Bachao-Beti Padhao scheme**.
- Vice President Venkaiah Naidu has asked state governments to make their respective mother tongues a mandatory subject in schools.
- The **Bihar** government is going to grant **reservation** in promotions to **employees** belonging to **Scheduled Castes (SC) / Scheduled Tribes (ST) categories**.
- The West Bengal Assembly has passed the resolution to change the state's name to 'Bangla'.
- The **Assam** government has made it mandatory for its staff to take care of their **elderly parents** and **differently-abled siblings** who don't have an income source.
  - Employees found neglecting their dependent parents and siblings will face a **10**% **and 15**% **salary cut** respectively.
- **Rajasthan** will soon have its 1st 'cow sanctuary', a shelter for 10,000 bovines spread over an area of more than 220 hectares in **Bikaner** district.

• The **Bihar** government has raised the **compensation** awarded to **Acid Attack Victims** from Rs.3 lakh to **Rs.7** lakh, while victims aged **under 14** years will receive 50% more compensation.

• **Thetford**, a small town in the **United Kingdom** will be converted into a **twin city** of **Amritsar** in the memory of the last king of the Sikh Empire, **Maharaja Duleep Singh**.

#### **Personalities**

- Angela Ponce, who has been crowned Miss Universe Spain, will be the first ever transgender model competing at the Miss Universe pageant 2018.
- Marathon runner **Sameer Singh**, who completed a 13,750-km-run across India over a span of seven months and six days to spread awareness about '**Bharat Ke Veer**', was felicitated at Attari-Wagah border.
  - Bharat Ke Veer is a government initiative dedicated towards the welfare of **martyrs' families**.
- The Death Anniversary of 11th President of India, Bharat Ratna **Dr Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam (A. P. J. Abdul Kalam)** was observed on July 27.

## **Defence and National Security**

- **India** is in the process of inducting the first batch of its intercontinental ballistic missile system, **Agni-V**, which will bring targets across **China** within its range, and is expected to significantly bolster the country's military prowess.
- Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas was formally inducted into Indian Air Force (IAF)'s 'Flying Daggers' squadron, which earlier had Russian MiG-21s.
- India's latest frontline warship INS Trikand has reached Sri Lanka in a goodwill visit.
- In a first, **Indian** Navy's **P-8I long-range Maritime Patrol Aircraft** has been inducted at **Hawaii** for participating in the **Rim of the Pacific (RIMPAC) exercise**, which is the world's largest international maritime exercise.
- **India** is going to buy the **Russian S-400 Triumf air defence missile** despite US sanctions on military transactions with Russia, Defence Minister **Nirmala Sitharaman** announced.
- Turkey signed a deal to sell 30 T129 ATAK helicopters to Pakistan.
  - The T129 ATAK Multirole Combat Helicopter has been optimized for specific hot and high performance requirements of the Turkish Armed Forces.
- The **Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO)** has successfully test-fired **Supersonic Cruise Missile** under extreme **weather** conditions, as part of the service life extension programme for **Indian Army**.
  - The missile was fired from a mobile autonomous launcher from the Integrated Test Range at Balasore, Odisha.
- For the first time, the **Indian Air Force** is going to participate in **Exercise Pitch Black**, a three-week multinational warfare exercise hosted by the **Royal Australian Air Force**.
  - The IAF contingent will consist of 145 air-warriors including a Garud commando team and four Sukhoi-30 MKI fighter planes.
- **Iran** is planning to jointly manufacture **Defence Equipment** with **Pakistan** and present them as a joint achievement of Muslim nations.
  - This announcement came in line with a meeting between Chairman of the Chiefs of Staff of the Iranian Armed Forces Major General Mohammad Baqeri and Pakistani President Mamnoon Hussain.
- Defence Minister **Nirmala Sitharaman** formally handed over two types of **indigenously built high-power multi-fuel engines** to the Army.

- Indian Army has awarded Rs.100-crore contract for 81 high mobility 10×10 vehicles to India's leading vehicle manufacturer Ashok Leyland.
- India is going to procure National Advanced Surface-to-Air Missile System-II (NASAMS-II), an advanced air defence system at \$1 billion from United States.

## Committees/Commissions

- The Union Government has constituted **13-member Committee for Sub-National Accounts** to upgrade the norms for computation of economic data at states and districts level in backdrop of plans to revise the base year for **National Accounts or Gross Domestic Production** (GDP) calculation.
  - Head of this Committee: Ravindra H Dholakia.
- The **Odisha** government has constituted a 'Heritage Cabinet' to preserve the **Odia language** and the state's culture.
  - The cabinet comprises eight members and will be headed by Chief Minister **Naveen Patnaik**.
- The **Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC)** launched its in-house developed, single-umbrella e-marketing system named **Khadi Institution Management and Information System (KIMIS)** in **New Delhi**.
- The **high-level committee** on **restructuring stressed assets** and creating more value for public sector banks (PSBs) has suggested a **transparent market-based solution** with a focus on asset turnaround to ensure job protection and creation.
  - Head of this Committee: **Sunil Mehta** (Non-Executive Chairman of Punjab National Bank)
- The standing committee of National Board for Wildlife (NBWL) has recently added four species into Centre's Recovery Programme for Critically Endangered Species.
  - They are: Northern River Terrapin, Clouded Leopard, Arabian Sea Humpback Whale, Red Panda.
- The **Kerala** government has set up a panel of **eminent writers and language experts** to choose a '**Kerala Ganam**', an **official song for the state**.
  - Head of this Panel: Rani George Al SCHOOL OF BANKII
- The **Law Commission** has recommended that **gambling and betting** on **sports** including **cricket** should be **allowed in India** as regulated activities under the **direct and indirect tax regimes**.
  - It further recommended linking **Aadhaar** or **PAN card** of individuals involved in such activities.
- The Union Government constituted a **high-level task force to identify various items and policy interventions** to reduce dependence on **imports**.
  - Head of this Task force: PK Sinha (Cabinet Secretary)
- The government has decided to set up a committee to suggest measures to **strengthen National Cadet Corps** (NCC) & **National Service Scheme** (NSS).
  - Chairman of this Committee: Anil Swarup (former Secretary, School Education)
- The Centre announced a **4-member committee** to suggest laws against **lynching** and **mob** violence
  - This comes after the Supreme Court asked the Parliament to come up with a law on lynchings.
  - Head of this Committee: **Rajiv Gauba** (Union Home Secretary)
- A panel headed by retired Supreme Court judge **B N Srikrishna** submitted its report to the government on suggestions for a **data protection law** that will also cover **Aadhaar**.
  - It also suggested various penalties for violation of data privacy.
- Insurance regulator Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has constituted a 16-member committee to examine motor third party insurance pricing aspects and make recommendations on the premium rates for 2019-20. Head of this Committee: P. J. Joseph

- The **National Green Tribunal (NGT)** formed a monitoring committee on the cleaning of the **Yamuna** and directed it to submit an action plan on the issue.
- Union Government has constituted **High Level Empowered Committee** headed by Cabinet Secretary to address issues of **Stressed Thermal Power Projects**.

  - This centre will create **Technology Data Bank** from each side to encourage technology transfers, production of high quality products in India.
- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** inaugurated '**Dharohar Bhawan**' the new headquarters building of the **Archaeological Survey of India (ASI)** at Tilak Marg in **New Delhi**.
- Home Minister Rajnath Singh along with his Bangladeshi counterpart Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal inaugurated India's largest visa centre in the world in Bangladesh's capital Dhaka.
- Union Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation (MDWS) has launched Swachh Survekshan Grameen 2018 (SSG 2018) in New Delhi.
- To increase green cover in the state, the **Haryana** Chief Minister **Manohar Lal Khattar** has launched a unique program titled '**Paudhagiri campaign**'.
- The National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has launched Centre for Climate Change in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.

- Ministry of Earth Sciences has unveiled state-of-the-art Air Quality and Weather Forecast System-SAFAR at Chandni Chowk in Delhi.
  - SAFAR System of Air Quality and Weather Forecasting And Research
- The Chief Minister of Odisha, Naveen Patnaik launched the 'Green Mahanadi Mission'.
  - **Objective**: To stop soil erosion on river banks and recharges the groundwater reserve.
- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** launched 81 investment projects worth Rs.60,000 crore in a record breaking event in **Uttar Pradesh**.

- The 4th edition of **BIMSTEC Summit** will be held in **Khatmandu** (Nepal's capital) from 30th to 31st August 2018.
- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** joined fellow BRICS leader at the **10th BRICS Summit**, which was held at **Johannesburg**, **South Africa**.

  - India signed several MoUs in the fields of education, skill, health, and agriculture with South Africa.
  - Modi held separate bilateral meetings with Chinese President Xi Jinping and Russian President Vladimir Putin on the sidelines of the summit.
- The 2nd Young Superintendent of Police Conference was held in New Delhi.
  - The 2-day conference was inaugurated by Union Home Minister **Rajnath Singh**.
  - Theme: "Predictive Policing and Contemporary Challenges for Indian Police Forces".
- The International Conference on strengthening economic ties between India and Vietnam was recently held at New Delhi.
- The 2-day **Unified Commanders' Conference (UCC)** for the year 2018 concluded at **New Delhi**.

# Agreement/Deal/Signed

- **Germany's** multinational conglomerate company **Thyssenkrupp** and India's **Tata Steel** signed a final agreement to establish a steel joint venture, marking the European steel industry's largest deal in 12 years.
  - The deal will create Europe's second-largest steelmaker after **ArcelorMittal**.
- The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) has come into an agreement with the Andhra Pradesh government to set up a 'Design University for Gaming' in Visakhapatnam.
- India's upper house of parliament Rajya Sabha and Senate of Rwanda has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for promoting inter-parliamentary dialogue capacity building and cooperation.
  - This MOU was signed between Vice President and Rajya Sabha Chairman Venkaiah Naidu and visiting President of Senate of Rwanda, Bernard Makuza in New Delhi.
- Gujarat Government's Industries and Mines Department has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Korea Trade-Investment Promotion Agency (KOTRA) to strengthen trade, industrial relations.
- **India** and **United Kingdom** has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on cooperation in the sphere of **Law & Justice and establishing Joint Consultative Committee**.
- Indian Army has singed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with State bank of India (SBI) on Defence Salary Package.

- **India** is going to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with **Bangladesh** to ease visa restrictions for citizens from the neighboring country.
- The member states of the **United Nations** have finalized text of the **Global Compact for Safe**, **Orderly and Regular Migration**, marking the first time they came together to negotiate an agreement covering all dimensions of **international migration**.
- State-owned defence electronics company **Bharat Electronics Ltd (BEL)** has signed memorandum of understanding (MoU) with **Swedish Aerospace** and defence firm **Saab** for jointly marketing **L-Band 3D air surveillance radar** (RAWL-03) which is co-developed by the companies.
- Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe and European Union (EU) leaders signed a free trade agreement, eliminating tariffs on a majority of their products to enhance business between the two sides.
- American multinational retail corporation Walmart has signed a five-year partnership with Microsoft to use the company's cloud services in retail.
- All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) and IIT (Indian Institute of Technology)-Delhi have signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to enhance research in the field of Ayurveda.
  - The MoU was signed on sidelines of two-day conference on 'Raising towards Excellence' held at New Delhi.
- The UN Environment Programme (UNEP) has entered into partnership with search engine giant Google to monitor impacts of human activity on global ecosystems by using sophisticated online tools.
  - The partnership was launched during **High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development** at United Nations (UN) headquarters in New York.
- India and Sri Lanka signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on a Sanitation Sector Project under which 3400 toilets would be constructed in Batticaloa District of Sri Lanka.
- India's biggest power producer NTPC (National Thermal Power Corporation) Limited has signed a term loan agreement with HDFC Bank for availing a loan of Rs.1500 crore.
- The Union Cabinet has approved the signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) amongst **BRICS Nations** (Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa) on **Regional Aviation Partnership** Cooperation.
- The **Power Grid Corporation of India (POWERGRID)** has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with **Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation (UPPCL)** for energy efficiency and agricultural demand side management programme.
- India has extended Rs.1378 crore (\$200 million) Lines of Credit (LOCs) to Rwanda after PM Narendra Modi held talks with the nation's President Paul Kagame. The two countries signed agreements on industrial and agricultural development.
- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** and President of the Republic of Rwanda **Paul Kagame** witnessed signing of **8 Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs)** between the two countries.
- **India** and **Uganda** signed **4 MoUs** in the areas of defence cooperation, visa exemption for official and diplomatic passport holders, cultural exchange programme and material testing laboratory.
- **Invest India** and **Business France** have signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote investment facilitation and cooperation between startups of India and France.
- **Sri Lanka**'s government signed an agreement to sell a 70% stake in a **\$1.5 billion Hambantota port** to **China** in a bid to recover from the heavy burden of repaying a Chinese loan obtained to build the facility.
- Maharashtra's women commission signed an agreement with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) for rescue and rehabilitation of women who are victims of sex trafficking, acid attack and domestic violence.

- The 5th Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) intercessional ministerial meeting was held in Tokyo, Japan.
  - This meeting was co-chaired by Singapore's Minister of Trade and Industry Chan Chun Sing and his Japanese counterpart Hiroshige Seko.
- Prime Minister of **Bhutan Tshering Tobgay** was visited to **India** for a three-day visit.
  - Aim: To discuss about economic cooperation and security ties.
- The **2nd meeting of the Joint Working Group on Tourism Cooperation** between **India** and **Nepal** was concluded in **Kathmandu**, **Nepal**.
  - The meeting also decided to set up an industry-led India Nepal Tourism Forum.
- **US** Secretary of State **Mike Pompeo** met with **North Korean** officials in **Pyongyang** to discuss Nuclear disarmament and improving bilateral relations.
- South Korean President Moon Jae-in was visited to India.
  - India and South Korea Sign 5 MoUs in the fields of Science & Technology.
- The 6th meeting of BRICS Education Ministers was held at Cape Town, South Africa.
  - The Union Minister of State for HRD, **Dr Satya Pal Singh** represented India in this meeting.
  - Theme: "Deepening BRICS Education Partnerships and Exchanges".
- The 1st Meeting of Sub-Group of Chief Ministers on coordination between MGNREGA and Agriculture was recently held at NITI Aayog on 13 July, 2018.
- External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj embarked on a two-day visit to Manama (Bahrain).
  - During this visit, She was co-chair the second high joint commission meeting with her Bahraini counterpart Sheikh Khalid bin Ahmed Al Khalifa.
- India's first government-sponsored 'Transgender Poets' Meet' was organized at the Sahitya Akademi in West Bengal's Kolkata.
  - The meet was chaired by India's first transgender college principal **Manabi Bandyopadhyay**.
- Union home minister **Rajnath Singh** was on a 3-day visit to **Bangladesh**.
  - He also signed Revised Travel Agreement (RTA 2018) with Bangladesh to ease visa restrictions for citizens from the neighbouring country.
- India and the United States are going to hold the inaugural 2+2 dialogue led by India's External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj, Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman and their US counterparts in New Delhi on September 6.
- The **10th edition of Delhi Dialogue (DD X)** was recently held in **New Delhi**.
  - This dialogue was hosted by Union External Affairs Minister **Sushma Swaraj**.
  - Theme: "Strengthening India-ASEAN Maritime Cooperation".
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited to Rwanda, Uganda and South Africa for a 5 day visit from July 23.
  - Prime Minister Narendra Modi was gifted 200 cows as a contribution from India to Rwanda's 'Girinka' (one cow per family) scheme.

- The 8th BRICS Health Ministers' Meeting was held at Durban, South Africa.
  - Indian delegation was led by **J P Nadda**, Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare.
  - In this meeting, he stated that India is committed to eliminating TB by 2025.
- Chinese Vice Foreign Minister Kong Xuanyou was on a three-day visit to Bhutan.
  - Kong has met Bhutan's King Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck and Prime Minister Tshering Tobgay.
- The 1st meeting of the **India-Bangladesh Joint Committee on Border Haats** was held in **Agartala**, **Tripura**.
  - They also held extensive discussions on issues related to review of operations of four functional Border Haats viz. Kalaichar (Meghalaya), Balat (Meghalaya), Kamlasagar (Tripura) and Srinagar (Tripura).
- After his visit to **Hathras** (UP), **Yogi Adityanath** became the 1st Uttar Pradesh CM to visit all the **75 districts** in the state in 16 months of his government's rule.
- "The International Congress of Parliamentary Women's Caucuses" will be held at Dublin Castle, Ireland during 9th and 10th of September 2018.
  - This conference is being organized by the Irish Women's Parliamentary Caucus (IWPC), a cross-party forum for female parliamentarians within the Irish parliament.
- The 6th India-UK Science & Innovation Council (SIC) meeting was held at New Delhi.
  - Dr. Harsh Vardhan, Minister of Science & Technology, Earth Sciences & Environment, Forests and Climate Change, India and Mr. Sam Gyimah, Minister for Universities, Science, Research and Innovation, UK led the Indian and UK delegations respectively.

#### **Bills**

- The Union Cabinet has approved The DNA Technology (Use and Application) Regulation Bill 2018.
  - The Bill aims at **expanding application of DNA-based forensic technologies** to support and strengthen justice delivery system of the country.
- Madhya Pradesh government has launched an outstanding power bill waiver scheme and subsidized power scheme titled 'Sambal' for laborers and poor families.
  - Under the Sambal scheme, the Below Poverty Line (BPL) families would be provided electricity at a cost of 200 rupees per month.
- The **National Board of Wildlife** has recommended that states use **Section 144**, which prohibits the assembly of four or more people, during wildlife emergencies.
- President Ram Nath Kovind has given his assent to Assam Witch Hunting (Prohibition, Prevention and Protection) Bill, 2015.
  - The law aims to eliminate superstition from society by making such offences under it as non-bailable, non-compoundable and cognizable.
- Lok Sabha also passed The **Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (Second Amendment) Bill, 2017** to abolish the 'no detention policy' in schools.
- The Lok Sabha passed the **Fugitive Economic Offenders Bill, 2018.** 
  - This bill aims to allow authorities to attach and confiscate properties of economic offenders who flee the country.
- The Lok Sabha passed the **National Council for Teacher Education (Amendment) Bill** to grant retrospective recognition to Central/State institutions that are conducting **teacher education** courses without **NCTE approval**.
- Lok Sabha passed **Negotiable Instruments (Amendment) Bill**, a Bill on **cheque bounce** cases.
  - This bill provides for allowing a court trying an offence related to cheque bouncing to direct the drawer to pay interim compensation to the complainant.

- The Parliament passed Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Bill, 2018.
  - This is an anti-corruption Bill that provides punishment to bribe givers and takers, and extends prior nod for prosecution to former public officials with the Lok Sabha giving its assent to the law.
- The Rajya Sabha passed the **Fugitive Economic Offenders Bill, 2018**.
  - This bill empowers authorities to confiscate the assets of economic offenders who flee the country.
- Lok Sabha passed the Trafficking of Persons (Prevention, Protection and Rehabilitation) Bill, 2018.
  - This bill calls for punishment ranging from 10 years of imprisonment and a fine of not less than Rs.1 lakh to offenders.
- The Criminal Law (Amendment) Bill, 2018, which provides for stringent punishment including Death penalty for those convicted of raping girls below the age of 12 years, was passed in Lok Sabha.
- Lok Sabha has passed **Homoeopathy Central Council (Amendment) Bill, 2018** by voice vote to replace Ordinance promulgated by President in May 2018.

#### **Fund**

- The 5 Committee (Administrative and Budgetary) of **United Nations General Assembly (UNGA)** has approved **US \$6.69 billion dollar** budget for **13 peacekeeping operations** for year 2018-19.
  - The budget approved for missions include MINUJUSTH (UN Mission for Justice Support in Haiti), MINUSCA (Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Central African Republic), MINURSO (Mission for Referendum in Western Sahara), MONUSCO (Stabilization Mission in Democratic Republic of the Congo) and UNIFIL (United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon).
  - The **United States** is the biggest contributor to the United Nations, paying 22 per cent of the \$5.4 billion core budget and 28.5 per cent of the \$7.9 billion peacekeeping budget, followed by **China** (10.3 per cent) and **Japan** (9.7 per cent).
- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved the proposal to expand the scope of the **Higher Education Funding Agency (HEFA)** to mobilize **Rs.1 lakh crore** for **research and academic infrastructure** for higher education institutions by **2022**.
- The Central government is planning to launch **7 Greenfield projects** to construct 3,000km of expressways under the **Rs.5.35 trillion Bharatmala scheme**.
- The **Asian Development Bank (ADB)** has approved **Lining Project of Son canal** in Shahabad-Bhojpur region of **Bihar**.
  - The estimated cost of this project is US \$503 million (Rs.3272.49 crore) out of which US \$352 million is being provided by ADB.
- The **United States** has released **\$200 million** in military assistance to **Ukraine**.
- The **Maharashtra** government has announced a special package worth over **Rs.21,000 crore** for the development of industries, agriculture and tourism in the **Vidarbha and Marathwada** regions.

# **Economy**

- The **growth rate** of India's **Foreign Direct Investment** (**FDI**) inflows recorded a five-year low of 3% to \$44.85 billion in 2017-18.
  - The sectors that received maximum foreign inflows include services (\$6.7 billion), computer software and hardware (\$6.15 billion), and telecommunications (\$6.21 billion).
  - Mauritius emerged as the largest source of FDI in India with \$15.94 billion in 2017-18.

- **Karnataka** Chief Minister **HD Kumaraswamy** presented the 1st budget of his Janata Dal (Secular)-Congress coalition government in the Vidhana Soudha.
  - Presenting this budget, he announced a farm loan waiver of **Rs.34,000 crore**.
  - Loans of up to Rs.2 lakh for each farmer will be waived.
  - Farmers who repaid the loan within time will be credited the repaid loan amount or **Rs.**25000 whichever is less.
- Consumer or Retail Inflation accelerated to 5% to hit a five-month high in June this year, well above May's 4.87%, majorly due to rise in the fuel prices.
- **India's Trade Deficit** widened to its highest in over five years in June driven largely by a surge in oil imports.
  - It widened to \$16.6 billion due to a rise in oil imports that surged 56.61% to \$12.73 billion.
  - Further, merchandise exports last month rose 17.57% to \$27.7 billion from a year ago.
- Australia has released a report on its Economic Strategy for India recommending that India should be put into its top three export markets and made the third largest destination in Asia for the country's outward investment.
  - The report titled 'An India Economic Strategy to 2035' authored by former Australian high commissioner to India Peter Varghese — was welcomed by Australian Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull.
- The **International Monetary Fund (IMF)** has cut **India's GDP growth** forecast by 10 basis points to 7.3% in 2018 and 7.5% in 2019 for India as against 6.7% in 2017.
- **Inflation** in **Venezuela** could top 10,00,000% by the end of the year as the country faces its worst economic crisis, the **International Monetary Fund** has announced.
- **Venezuela** is going to remove five zeroes from its **bolivar currency** rather than the three zeroes originally planned.
- The **Iranian rial** plunged to a record low of **100000** against the US dollar on the unofficial market, as the country faces US sanctions.

- Reliance Industries Chairman Mukesh Ambani announced that Reliance is India's largest payer of Goods and Services Tax (GST), Excise and Customs Duty, and Income Tax in the Private Sector.
- **South Korean** multinational conglomerate **Samsung** opened the world's largest mobile phone manufacturing factory in **Noida**, **Uttar Pradesh**.
- Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Industries Limited crossed the \$100-billion market cap mark.
  - With this, the company will join with **Tata Consultancy Services (TCS)** as the only **two** \$100-billion companies in India.
- Fertilizer major **Indian Farmers Fertilizer Cooperative** (**IFFCO**) has launched e-commerce platform **IFFCO iMandi** (a mobile application and web portal) to address all needs of the farming community associated with it.
- Messaging app **WhatsApp** has announced that it is testing a **limit** on **forwarding** messages to **five chats** at one time in **India**.
- American online social media and social networking service company, Facebook has announced
  that it is working on a new satellite project, named Athena, which will provide broadband internet
  connections to rural and underserved areas.
- Google is working on a new operating system (OS) titled 'Fuchsia' which will replace Android.

- **Indian** e-commerce payment system and digital wallet company, **Paytm** is going to launch its services in **Japan**.
  - The platform will launch the service in collaboration with Japanese multinational conglomerate
     SoftBank.
  - Last year, Paytm launched its services in **Canada**.
- Internet search engine giant Google unveiled two new Artificial Intelligence (AI) chips aimed at helping customers develop and deploy intelligent connected devices at scale. They are: Edge TPU (Tensor Processing Unit), Cloud IoT Edge.
- Digital payments major **Paytm**'s parent company One97 Communications is going to build the Headquarters of **Paytm** at **Noida's Sector 137**.
- India is going to ask e-commerce and social media firms like **Amazon** and **Facebook** to store customer data locally.
- Homegrown e-commerce startup **Flipkart** is set to enter financial services business and has applied for an **NBFC** (**Non-Banking Financial Company**) **license** to focus on consumer lending.

• The Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) has secured a Trademark for its iconic building Phiroze Jeejeebhoy Towers at Dalal Street in Mumbai.

## **Exports/Imports**

- Iran has overtaken Saudi Arabia to become the 2nd largest oil supplier to Indian state-owned firms during the June quarter.
  - **Iraq** is the largest oil supplier to India.

#### Taxation/Trade

- The Central Board of Direct Taxation (CBDT) extended the deadline for the PAN-Aadhaar linking from June 30, 2018, to March 31, 2019.
- The **Income Tax Department** has launched instant **Aadhaar-based e-PAN** allotment service for individuals seeking PAN (Permanent Account Number) service for the first time.
- To protect interest of consumers, the **Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs** (CBIC) has developed and launched a mobile app named '**GST Verify**'.
- Finance Secretary **Hasmukh Adhia** announced that the GST Council is considering bringing **petroleum products** under **Goods and Services Tax (GST)**.
- Union Finance Ministry has hiked **Threshold Monetary Limit** for **tax departments** to file appeals in tax cases.
- The **Goods and Services Tax Council** has cut **GST** tax rates for **88 items** including refrigerators, water coolers, washing machines, vacuum cleaners, small-screen TVs.
  - The GST of these items have been shifted from 28% to 18% slab.
  - The council has also reduced the tax rate on **ethanol** used to **blend petrol** and **diesel** to 5% from 18%.
  - Furthermore, the GST on **e-books** has been reduced from 18% to 5% as a "green initiative."
  - Sanitary napkins, rakhis, and idols made of stone, marble, and wood have been exempted from GST.
- The **Ministry of Finance** has extended the **Deadline** for filing of income tax returns to **August 31**, **2018**, for categories of taxpayers who were to file their returns by July 31.

## Space

- As part of its preparations to send an Indian astronaut into space using an indigenous rocket in the
  future, the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) successfully tested the Crew Escape
  System, which is critical to ensure safety of the astronauts in case a rocket explodes on the launch
  pad.
- China successfully launched **two** remote sensing satellites **PRSS-1** and **PakTes-1A** of **Pakistan** on board of **Long March-2C rocket** from **Jiuquan Satellite Launch Centre**.
- The **Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO)** has successfully conducted ground test of its high thrust version of **Vikas Engine** that would improve the payload capability of the space agency's launch vehicles.
  - The test for duration of 195 seconds was conducted by scientists at the ISRO Propulsion Complex (IPRC) in **Mahendragiri in Tirunelveli** district of Tamil Nadu.
- China is planning to launch 300 low-orbit satellites to provide worldwide communication services.
  - The first in the 300-satellite array known as the **Hongyan constellation** is set to be launched by the end of this year.
- **UK Space Agency** has selected site at **Sutherland** on **A'Mhoine peninsula** on north coast of **Scotland** for its first spaceport to launch rockets vertically and put satellites in orbit.
  - For development of this spaceport, UK Government is going to provide **\$3.3 million** funding and will be built with help of consortium of companies.
- World's richest person **Jeff Bezos**-founded aerospace startup **Blue Origin** successfully launched its space capsule, **New Shepard**, breaking its own record of highest-ever test flight at nearly 120 km.
  - The launch lasted around two and half minutes with the capsule hitting a maximum speed of 3,598 kmph.
- The **Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO)** has roped in **three partners** to help it assemble **27 satellites** at a quick pace over the next three years.
  - ISRO's nodal satellites division URSC (U.R. Rao Satellite Centre) signed separate three-year contracts with Alpha Design Technologies P Ltd and its six consortium members; with defense public enterprise Bharat Electronics Ltd; and with Tata Advanced Systems Ltd, Hyderabad.
- The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) has launched 'Remote Sensing Toolkit' to promote commercial use of satellite data.
- Elon Musk-led space startup **SpaceX** launched the **Telstar 19 Vantage satellite** through it's Falcon 9 rocket.
  - Weighing over 7,000 kg, this is the world's **heaviest** commercial communications satellite.
- After tests and configurations spanning three months in space, NASA's latest planet-hunting spacecraft **TESS** (Transiting Exoplanet Survey Satellite) has begun science operations.

## Science and Technology

- The National Advisor Bureau Limited (NABL) of the UAE has proposed to tow icebergs from Antarctica to use them as new sources of water in the Middle East.
  - With an estimated cost of \$50-60 million, the project will begin with the pilot phase in 2019.
- **Scientists** from **New Zealand** have performed the first-ever **3-D**, **colour X-ray** on a human body, using the imaging technology developed for the Large Hadron Collider at the CERN physics lab.
- **South Africa** has unveiled the 64-dish **MeerKAT radio telescope**, slated to be the world's largest and most powerful **telescope** on its completion in **2030**.
- Trinity supercomputer, hosted at the Los Alamos National Lab, US, has made a world record of creating 1 trillion files in two minutes.

- American and Spanish scientists have discovered a new 3D shape called '**Scutoid**' while studying human tissue folds which form the skin, cavity and organ linings.
  - The twisted prism-like shape has **5 sides** at one end and **6 sides** at the other end, besides a **triangular surface** on one of its longer edges.

## Health/Diseases/Drugs

- Union Health and Family Welfare Minister **J P Nadda** confirmed that **fruit bats** are the source of the **Nipah virus infection**, which killed 17 people in **Kerala**.
- The World Health Organization (WHO) recognized Sex addiction as a mental health disorder in its International Classification of Diseases list.
  - Earlier, WHO declared **gaming** addiction as a mental health disorder.
- To control viral hepatitis C, the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has launched **National Viral Hepatitis Control Programme** on the occasion of **World Hepatitis Day** (July 28).

# Energy/Gas/Oil

- **Russia** is going to build **two Nuclear Power Units** in **China** which are expected to be operational by **2026** and **2027** respectively.
  - Russia's state nuclear power corporation Rosatom and China's National Energy Administration signed a deal to build the two 1,200-megawatt units at the Tianwan nuclear power plant.
- The Union Minister **Jitendra Singh** announced that **21 Nuclear Reactors** with a total installed capacity of 15,700 megawatt are currently under construction.
  - Currently, there are nine nuclear power reactors at various stages of construction which are expected to be completed by 2024-25.
- Union Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas has amended Petroleum and Natural Gas Rules 1959 to include 'shale' in definition of petroleum.
  - This change will allow private companies to explore and produce the resource in the blocks they already operate.

#### **Environment**

- The **Union Environment Ministry** has set **Noise Standards** for **Airports** across the country, excluding defence aircraft, and those that are landing and taking off.
  - According to rules, a civil airport with more than 50,000 aircraft movements per year should not exceed noise levels beyond 75 dB (A) Leq (decibels) during the daytime and 65 dBA during the night.

# Education

- HRD Minister **Prakash Javadekar** announced that the national-level engineering and medical entrance examinations, **JEE Main** and **NEET**, will be held **twice** a year from 2019.
  - The examinations will be conducted online by the newly-formed National Testing Agency (NTA).
- The Government has shortlisted **Six Institutions of Eminence (IoEs)** including 3 from Public Sector and 3 from Private Sector.
  - It is expected that these Institutions will come up in **top 500** of the **world ranking** in 10 years and in top 100 of the world ranking eventually overtime.
- The National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) has initiated process of introducing QR code (Quick Response code) in their textbooks.

#### **Transport/Cars/Scooters**

• State-run Airports Authority of India (AAI) is going to set up state-of-the-art Civil Aviation Research Organization (CARO) at Hyderabad's Begumpet Airport.

- **Richard Branson-led** commercial spaceflight **Virgin Galactic** has announced that it is going to launch its commercial space flights from **Italy**.
  - It has partnered with Italian Space Agency-owned Company **Altec** and **Sitael**, Italy's private space company to develop a framework for how spaceflights will be conducted.
- **Ministry of Railways** approves **Digital Aadhaar** and **Driving License** from Digital Locker as proof of identity of passengers for undertaking journey by Train.
- The 1st cruise service between **Mumbai** and **Goa** will begin from August 1, Road Transport and Shipping Minister **Nitin Gadkari** announced.
- A draft amendment to the **Central Motor Vehicles Rules** has proposed that **driving license** and **pollution control certificates** can be carried in **physical or digital** form, **Ministry of Road Transport and Highways** has announced.
  - The amendment further proposes that vehicle tracking systems and FASTags for electronic toll collection will be made mandatory for all commercial vehicles obtaining national permit.
- In a bid to strengthen expertise and capabilities of the employees of North-Eastern Railways, the Indian Railways inaugurated Regional Rail Training Institute (RRTI) at Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh.
- **Delhi Metro** recently became the 1st Metro system in the World to go Completely Green.

#### Films and Film Festival

- Bollywood actor Irrfan Khan has been honored with Icon Award at the London Indian Film Festival (LIFF) 2018.
  - Actress Richa Chadha won the Outstanding Achievement Award, while Manoj Bajpayee was also awarded an Icon Award.
- National Film Archive of India host European Union Film Festival 2018 from 6th July to 12th July in Mumbai.
  - Opening movie is 9 Month Stretch (French film).

  - Top 5: Switzerland, The Netherlands, Sweden, The United Kingdom, Singapore.
- According to a recently released World Bank report, **India** is the **6th** largest economy in the world, with a GDP of **\$2.59 trillion** in 2017.
  - India surpassed France and is behind the **US**, **China**, **Japan**, **Germany** and the **UK**.
  - Further, the World Bank estimated the Indian economy to grow by **7.3**% in 2018 and **7.5**% in the next two years.
