Reserve Bank of India

- Cross-platform messaging and Voice over IP (VoIP) service WhatsApp is seeking a formal
 approval of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to expand its payment services to all of its users in
 India.
 - WhatsApp's partner banks have also submitted a request for formal approval.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has kept the repo rate, the rate at which banks borrow from RBI, unchanged at **6.50**% in its 5th bi-monthly monetary policy review of 2018-19.
 - The **Reverse repo-rate**, the rate at which RBI borrows money from the banks, is **6.25** per cent.
 - Marginal standing facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate 6.75%.

- To provide cost-free mechanism to redress grievances of customers related to digital transactions, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is going to introduce 'Ombudsman Scheme for Digital Transactions'.
 - The scheme will be notified by end of January 2019.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** is going to introduce new modes of customer e-verification, including live video, in financial institutions.
 - RBI is also planning to introduce a digital method that would use XML internet format to extract limited information on customers from the Aadhaar database.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has imposed a fine of **Rs.1 crore** on state-owned **Indian Bank** for violating cyber security norms.
- The government announced that the **Public Sector Banks** don't have any plans to shut down their **ATMs**.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** announced that it has decided to scale up the amount of liquidity infusion by Rs.10,000 crore to Rs.50,000 crore in December.
 - RBI has already injected Rs.20,000 crore through two Open Market Operation (OMO) purchases.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has shortlisted six IT majors to set up **Public Credit Registry** (**PCR**) for capturing details of borrowers and wilful defaulters.
 - They are: TCS, Wipro, IBM India, Capgemini Technology Services India, Dun & Bradstreet Information Services India, and Mindtree.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) will soon introduce new Rs.20 currency notes with additional features.
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** is looking at a **mobile phone-based solution** to help visually impaired people easily identify Indian currency notes.
 - Currently, intaglio printing-based identification marks are present in banknotes of Rs.100 and above for helping the visually challenged identify them.
- As per a recent report by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), Banks recovered bad loans worth Rs.40,400 crore in 2017-18.
 - The loans were recovered through channels like the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC),
 SARFAESI Act, Debt Recovery Tribunals and Lok Adalats.
- In its annual report, the **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) has announced that the number of **ATMs** has declined marginally to 2.07 lakh in the financial year 2018 from 2.08 lakh in the financial year 2017.

State Bank of India

- India's largest lender **State Bank of India (SBI)** has offered for sale **three** of its **bad loan accounts** to recover dues worth Rs.2,111 crore.
 - The accounts, which belong to Sona Alloys, MCL Global Steel and Jayaswal Neco Industries, will be put up at an e-auction on December 13.

Other Banks

- Kolkata-based **Bandhan Bank** is going to open **40 branches** by end of December 2018 after the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) approved the move.
- India Post has started internet facility of the customers of Post office savings bank account.
 - The facility was launched by Union Minister for Communication (independent charge) Manoj Sinha at National Media Centre, New Delhi.
- The **IDFC Bank** has merged completely with the non-banking financial company **Capital First** into a new entity to be called as **IDFC First Bank**.

- 106th foundation day of India's first Swadeshi Bank 'Central Bank of India' was observed on 21st December.
- Public sector lender Bank of Baroda has announced that the 'Alternative Mechanism' of the finance ministry has accorded in-principle approval for its merger with Dena Bank and Vijaya Bank.
 - The 'Alternative Mechanism' (AM) headed by Finance Minister Arun Jaitley had decided to merge three banks with a view to create global size lender, which will be stronger and sustainable.
- The government has decided to infuse Rs.10,086 crore in the state run **Bank of India**.
 - The move is part of the government's plans to infuse Rs.83,000 crore into state-run banks by March, taking total infusion to Rs.1.06 lakh crore this fiscal.

Supreme Court

- Supreme Court has approved **Witness Protection Scheme 2018** and directed Union and State Governments to enforce the same.
 - Aim: To ensure that investigation, prosecution and trial of criminal offences does not turn out
 to be biased as witnesses are intimidated or frightened to give evidence without protection
 from violent or other criminal recrimination.
 - It was finalized in consultation with National Legal Services Authority (NALSA).
- The Supreme Court has barred **media** from revealing the identity of **sexual assault victims**, even if they are dead or if parents provide their consent.
 - It also said that the names of victims cannot be used at public rallies or on social media platforms.
- Supreme Court has given clean chit to Narendra Modi led BJP government for purchase of 36 Rafale fighter Jets.

High Courts and Sessions Courts

- The **Madras High Court** has ruled that **Drivers** don't need to carry physical copies of licence or other vehicle documents as **electronic copies** are valid.
- The **Delhi** High Court has ordered a ban on the sale of online medicines by **E-pharmacies** across the country.
- **Telangana** and **Andhra Pradesh** states will have **separate High Courts** from January 1, 2019.
- **Delhi High Court** has allowed that **Section 354A** of Indian Penal Code can be used by transgenders to register complaints of sexual harassment.

Election Commission

• Voting for 119-member **Telangana** Assembly and 200-member **Rajasthan** Assembly began on December 7.

Central Government

- The Center has rejected **Karnataka** government's request to recognize **Lingayat** as a **separate** religion.
- To spread awareness about **cybercrimes** and normal precautions to be taken, the **Union Ministry of Home Affairs** (MHA) has launched **Twitter** account titled **@CyberDost**.
- The Union Cabinet has approved the establishment of two new **All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS)** at **Tamil Nadu** (Madurai) and **Telangana** (Bibinagar).
- The government is going to launch **Broadband Services Readiness Index** of states based on parameters like infrastructure, approval processes and utilization of high-speed Internet.

- Aadhaar details for bank accounts or mobile phone connections will no longer be mandatory as
 Union Cabinet approved an amendment to the existing law, making Aadhaar details optional for
 these services.
 - The Supreme Court on September 26 had upheld the constitutional validity of Aadhaar.
- The **Home Ministry** has authorized **10 agencies** to monitor, intercept, and decrypt "any information generated, transmitted, received or stored in any computer".
 - The agencies include the Intelligence Bureau, CBI, Delhi Police Commissioner, RAW and Narcotics Control Bureau.
- The Union Cabinet approved a budget of **Rs.10,000 crore** for sending three Indian astronauts to space for up to 7 days by 2022 for the **Gaganyaan Programme**.
 - The programme will help India become the **4th nation** to have a manned mission to space.
- The proposal from the states of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Mizoram, Chhattisgarh, Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh for the implementation of **Mahila Police Volunteer Scheme** has been approved by the union government.
 - Under the scheme, the Mahila Police volunteer is required to mobilize community to form Mahila and ShishuRakshak Dals (MASRD) to act as community watch groups.

States

- **Bhopal** observed the **34th anniversary of gas leak tragedy**, one of the worst industrial disaster of the world.
- The 'Rakhi with Khaki' initiative by Chhattisgarh's Bilaspur police, as part of which girls and women tied rakhis to 50,033 police personnel and took selfies, has been acknowledged by the Guinness World Records.
- Odisha's Kandhamal Haldi (turmeric) will soon get Geographical Indications (GI) tag.
 - Kandhamal Haldi is famous for its healing properties.
- Maharashtra Government has launched World Bank assisted SMART Project to transform rural Maharashtra.
 - SMART State of Maharashtra's Agribusiness and Rural Transformation
 - This initiative is in line with Union Government's step towards doubling farmers' income by 2022
- Union Cabinet has approved implementation of **Shahpurkandi Dam Project** on river **Ravi**, **Punjab**.
- Shi Yomi formally became 23rd district of Arunachal Pradesh.
 - It was created by bifurcating West Siang district with its headquarters at Tato.
 - Two more districts Pakke-Kesang and Lepa Rada will be formally inaugurated in the state within taking the total to 25.
- The **Andhra Pradesh** government is going to install a 197-foot-tall statue of former Chief Minister of the state **N T Rama Rao (NTR)** in **Amravati**.
 - Estimated cost of the project is around Rs. 406 crore.
- The **Uttar Pradesh** government has announced that it will install four new statues in the state, including a 25-foot-tall statue of late Prime Minister **Atal Bihari Vajpayee** at Lok Bhawan in **Lucknow**.
 - A statue of Swami Vivekananda will be installed at Raj Bhawan, while 12.5-foot-tall statues of Mahant Avaidyanath and Mahant Digvijayanath will be installed in Gorakhpur.
- **Punjab** Legislative Assembly unanimously passed a resolution for seeking **30**% **reservation** for **women** in Parliament and State legislative assembly.
 - The resolution was moved by Chief Minister Captain Amarinder Singh, urging the Centre to enact it.

- As part of his electoral promise, Telangana Chief Minister **K** Chandrashekar Rao directed officials to begin the process of forming two new districts (**Mulugu** and **Narayanpet**) in the state.
 - Telangana was formed in 2014 with **10** districts and later split into **31 districts** in 2016.
- Haryana Government has launched a mobile app named as 'Shiksha Setu'.
 - The 'Shikhsa Setu' App will help in bringing transparency in the Education Department and in the administration of colleges in the state.
- After a period of 22 years, **President's rule** has been imposed in **Jammu and Kashmir**.
 - This comes after the Centre approved a proposal put forward by the state's Governor Satya Pal Malik.
- The **Delhi** Cabinet, chaired by Chief Minister **Arvind Kejriwal**, approved the 103-km-long **Delhi Metro Phase-IV project**.
- Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar has announced the renaming of Child Care Institutes being run in the state as Jagannath Ashrams.
- The newly-formed **Madhya Pradesh** government announced it is forming an **Adhyatmik Vibhag** (spiritual department) by merging several existing departments.
 - The Anand Vibhag (happiness department) formed by the previous BJP government, a first in the country, would be incorporated into the new department.
- The government has banned **Khalistan Liberation Force (KLF)** under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) for its involvement in several killings, bombings and other terror activities during its violent campaign for the secession of Punjab.
- The new government of **Rajasthan** has abolished the condition of a **minimum educational** qualification to contest local body elections.
- To encourage indigenous and specialized products and crafts of the state, the government of **Uttar Pradesh** has initiated **One District, One Product scheme**.
 - The scheme aims to capitalize the rich heritage of the Uttar Pradesh by reviving them through modernization and publicisation to enhance the reach of these products.

Place in the News

- **India** is set to get its 1st **underwater museum** off the **Puducherry** coast, giving a boost to tourism in the Union territory.
 - INS Cuddalore, a Pondicherry-class vessel that was decommissioned in March, will be turned
 into the country's first underwater museum.
- Union Railways Minister **Piyush Goyal** has dedicated **National Rail and Transportation Institution (NRTI)** to the Nation in **Vadodara**.
 - It is **India's 1st Railway University** and the 3rd in the world after **Russia** and **China**.

- The **Defence Ministry** cleared the proposal for procurement of military equipment worth **3,000 crore**.
 - The approved deal includes procurement of indigenous BrahMos missiles for two Indian Navy ships that are to be built in Russia.
- India and US Air forces began their 12-day joint exercise "Ex Cope India-2018" in West Bengal.
- The **Punjab** Cabinet cleared a proposal to set up an **International Civil Terminal** at Air Force Station, **Halwara in Ludhiana** district.
 - The terminal will be jointly developed by the state government and Airports Authority of India (AAI).
- The 1st bilateral air exercise between Japanese Air Self Defence Force (JASDF) and Indian Air Force (IAF) titled SHINYUU Maitri-18 was held in Air Force Station, Agra.
 - **Theme**: Joint Mobility/Humanitarian Assistance Disaster Relief (HADR) on Transport aircraft.
- Indian Navy is going to conduct its flagship large-scale coastal defence exercise Theatre Level Operational Readiness Exercise (TROPEX) from January to March 2019 to test robustness of entire coastal security apparatus.
 - As part of TROPEX, Indian Navy will conduct large-scale coastal defence exercise 'Exercise Sea Vigil'.
- The **Special Forces of India** and **United States** completed their 3-day tactical exercise titled '**Vajra Kayaa**'.
 - 'Vajra Kayaa' is a part of the joint military drill 'Vajra Prahar 2018'.
- Indian Coast Guard (ICG) has conducted Regional Level Marine Oil Pollution Response Exercise titled 'Clean Sea-2018' at sea off Port Blair, Andaman & Nicobar (A&B) Islands.
 - ICG ships Viswasth, Vijith, Rajveer, Rajshri, 4 interceptor boats and its air assets Dornier and Chetak helicopters participated in the exercise.
- The 2nd edition of service specific exercise **AVIAINDRA** between **Indian Air Force** and **Russian Federation Aerospace Force** (RFSAF) was held at Air Force Station **Jodhpur**, **Rajasthan**.
- The 10th edition of **INDRA NAVY** maritime exercise between India and Russia is being held at **Visakhapatnam** coast, Andhra Pradesh from December 9-16, 2018.
- Indigenously developed surface-to-surface nuclear-capable ballistic missile **Agni-5**, which has a strike range of 5,000 km, has been successfully test-fired from **Dr Abdul Kalam Island off the Odisha coast**.
- The 7th Hand-in-Hand Military exercise between India and China was held at Chengdu, China.
- Indigenously developed **Light Utility Helicopter (LUH)** by **Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL)** has achieved important milestone of flying at 6 km altitude in **Bangalore**, **Karnataka**.
 - With the completion of this milestone, LUH can now undertake high altitude cold weather trials planned in January 2019.
- Indian Navy inducted its 1st Submarine Rescue System with Deep Submergence Rescue Vessel (DSRV) along with associated equipment at western naval dockyard in Mumbai, Maharashtra (west coast of India).

- The government has constituted a 6-member committee to oversee the sale of **149 oil and gas fields** of state-owned ONGC, Oil India and other explorers.
 - **Head of this Committee**: Rajiv Kumar (NITI Aayog Vice Chairman)

- **Members**: PK Sinha (Cabinet Secretary) & Subhash Chandra Garg (Economic Affairs Secretary)
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** constituted a committee to propose long-term solutions for the economic and financial sustainability of **Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises** (MSMEs).
- The International Olympic Committee (IOC) has set up an Advisory committee on human rights, to include 'human rights standards' in Olympic host-city contracts beginning with the 2024 Olympic in Paris.
 - Head of this Committee: Zeid Ra'ad al-Hussein (former United Nations commissioner for human rights)
- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has set up an expert committee to suggest how the central bank should handle its reserves and whether it can transfer its surplus to the government.
 - Headed of this Committee: Bimal Jalan (former RBI governor)
 - **Vice Chairman**: Rakesh Mohan (former RBI deputy governor)
 - Members: Bharat Doshi and Sudhir Mankad (RBI central board directors), N.S. Vishwanathan (Deputy governor), and Subhash Chandra Garg (Economic affairs secretary).
- The government will soon be appointing a committee to oversee the implementation of the recommendations of the **Doubling Farmers' Income** (DFI) committee.

 - With the new additions, the number of sites under PRASAD has now reached to 41 in 25 states.
 - PRASAD Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi was inaugurated the Bogibeel Bridge on December 25.
 - Falling in the eastern part of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh, Bogibeel Bridge is India's longest railroad bridge.
- **Kerala** Chief Minister **Pinarayi Vijayan** and Minister for Commerce and Industry and Civil Aviation **Suresh Prabhu** inaugurated the **Kannur International Airport**.
 - This is Kerala's 4th International Airport.
- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** launched several development projects worth over **Rs.1000 crore** rupees at **Rae Bareli** in **Uttar Pradesh**.
 - He also flagged off the 900th coach and a rake of Humsafar train manufactured at Modern Coach Factory in Rae Bareli.
- The foundation stone for **Institute of High-Altitude Medicinal Plants (IHAMP)** was laid by Union Ministers **Jitendra Singh** and **Shripad Yesso Naik** (Ayush Ministry) at Bhaderwah, Doda district, **Jammu & Kashmir**.
- An **All-women political party** named 'National Women's Party (NWP)' was launched in **Delhi**.
 - Announcing the launch, party President **Swetha Shetty** announced that the party aims to get 50% reservation for women candidates in Parliament and other places.
- Modi also launched the **City and Industrial Development Corporation** (CIDCO) of Maharashtra's mass housing scheme, which offers affordable homes under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana.
 - PM Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of Thane-Bhiwandi-Kalyan Metro and Dahisar-Mira-Bhayander Metro corridors in Maharashtra.
- The government has approved the revamped **Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRSs)** scheme.
 - Under this scheme, Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRSs) will be set up in every block where Scheduled Tribes population is more than 50% and has at least 20,000 tribal persons.

- For the overall development of farmers **Odisha** Chief Minister **Naveen Patnaik** announced a Rs.10,000 crore scheme titled KALIA.
 - KALIA Krushak Assistance for Livelihood and Income Augmentation
 - This scheme will provide farmers with Rs.10,000 a year at the rate of Rs.5,000 each for Kharif and Rabi season.
 - Additionally, crop loans of up to Rs. 50,000 will be interest-free under the scheme.

 - The scheme will start from 2019-20 financial year.

 - The **Bhawan-Bhairon Passenger Ropeway Project** has cost around Rs.85 crore and has a carrying capacity of 800 persons per hour.

 - India and UAE also signed an agreement to undertake development projects in Africa.
- Panama has become the 1st Latin American country to join China's Belt and Road Initiative (BRI).
 - Chinese President Xi Jinping and Panama President Juan Carlos Varela signed more than a dozen deals in this regard.
- The European Parliament approved a free trade deal between Japan and the European Union, which is believed to be the world's largest free trade agreement.
- Russia confirmed that the United States of America (USA) has decided to cancel the Intermediate-Range Nuclear Forces (INF) Treaty signed between both countries in the year 1987.

Meet/Visit

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Chinese President Xi Jinping and Russian President Vladimir Putin met for the RIC (Russia-India-China) Trilateral Summit at the leaders' level after 12 years.
 - The meeting took place on sidelines of the G20 Summit.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi met European Council President Donald Tusk and European Commission President Jean-Claude Juncker on the sidelines of the G20 summit in Argentina.
- External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj was visited to United Arab Emirates (UAE).
 - During this visit, she was co-chairing the 12th session of the India-UAE Joint Commission Meeting for Economic and Technical Cooperation with Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed Al Nahyan (Foreign Minister of the UAE).
- President Ram Nath Kovind was visited to Myanmar for a 4-day visit.
 - During his stay, he visited capital Nay Pyi Taw and Yangon, and interact with his counterpart U Win Myint and State Counsellor Aung San Suu Kyi.
- The 18th meeting of the India-Russia Inter-Governmental Commission on Military Technical Cooperation (IRIGC-MTC) was recently held in New Delhi.
 - Indian Defense Minister Nirmala Sitharaman along with Russian Defence Minister General Sergei Shoigu jointly co-chaired the meeting.

- New Maldivian President Ibrahim Mohamed Solih was visited to India for a 3-day visit.
 - After the talks, PM Narendra Modi announced \$1.4 billion in financial aid to Maldives.
 - The two nations signed four pacts, including one on visa facilitation.
- The Commander-in-Chief of the Royal Thai Navy, **Admiral Luechai Ruddit**, called on Indian Navy Chief **Admiral Sunil Lanba** at Naval Headquarters, **New Delhi**.
- **India** and **China** held the 1st meeting of the high-level people-to-people exchanges mechanism.
 - This meeting was co-chaired by External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj and her Chinese counterpart Wang Yi.
 - Both the countries agreed on '10 pillars' of cooperation to enhance cultural and people-to-people exchanges.
- Prime Minister of Bhutan Lotay Tshering visited to India.
- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** during his visit to Port Blair officially announced the renaming of three islands in Andaman & Nicobar.
 - They are: Ross Island will now be called Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep
 - Neil Island will now be called Shaheed Dweep
 - Havelock Island will now be called Swaraj Dweep

Bills

- The Minister of State for Parliamentary affairs **Arjun Ram Meghwal** introduced **Dam Safety Bill 2018** in Lok Sabha.
 - The bill provides a uniform procedure for the safety of dams in country.
- The **Himachal Pradesh** Assembly passed a resolution to declare **Cow** as 'Rashtra Mata (mother of the nation)'.
- Jammu and Kashmir has passed law to ban sexual extortion of woman in offices.
 - With this, Jammu & Kashmir has become the 1st state in India to amend law on Sexual extortion.
- The Lok Sabha passed the Surrogacy (Regulation) Bill, 2016, which bans commercial surrogacy.
- The Lok Sabha also passed the **Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Bill, 2016**, which seeks to empower the transgender community in the country by providing them a separate identity.
- Aiming to reduce the number of mob lynchings in the state, the **Manipur** Assembly passed the 'Manipur Protection from Mob Violence Bill'.
 - This bill recommends life imprisonment for those involved in mob violence if it results in the death of a victim.
- The Lok Sabha has passed the **Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill, 2018**, following a debate.
 - The bill proposes to make the method of Muslim men instantly divorcing their wives by uttering "Talaq" thrice (Triple Talaq) as "unconstitutional" and "arbitrary" and suggests a threeyear jail term to husbands who follow the method.
- The Union Cabinet has approved amendments to the **Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act**, including the provision for death penalty for "committing aggravated penetrative sexual assault crime" on children.

Fund

- The Union Government (Ministry of Finance) and Asian Development Bank (ADB) has signed \$85 million loan agreement for Odisha Skill Development Project.
 - It aims to improve the skill development eco-system in Odisha and establish World Skill Center (WSC), an advanced skill training center in state capital Bhubaneswar.

- The **World Bank Group** announced that it will double its 5-year investments to **\$200 billion** to fight **climate change** between 2021-2025.
- **Germany** has offered Rs.720-crore low-interest loan to support reconstruction of bridges and roads that were damaged in **Kerala** flood.
 - German Ambassador to India **Martin Ney** announced that the country has also offered a technical grant of Rs.24 crore in infrastructure planning.
- The Government of India (GoI) and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) signed a Loan Agreement for \$31 million to build-up the State Tourism Industry and boost visitor arrivals.
- India announced financial assistance of Rs.4500 crore to Bhutan for its 12th Five Year Plan.

Economy

- **Venezuela's** President **Nicolás Maduro** has ordered a 150% increase in the monthly minimum wage to 4500 sovereign bolivars, worth about Rs.660 at the black market rate.
- Global rating agency **Fitch** lowered **India's GDP** growth forecast to **7.2**% in 2018-19, from 7.8% projected in September, citing higher financing costs and reduced credit availability.
- Finance Minister **Arun Jaitley** announced that the Centre has decided to increase its contribution to the **National Pension System** for the central government employees to **14**% from 10%.
 - The Centre also made the withdrawal of amount at the time of retirement tax free.
- In its recently released Outlook Supplement, the **Asian Development Bank (ADB)** has retained **India's growth forecast** at **7.3**% for current fiscal (2018-19) and **7.6**% in following financial year (2019-20).

Companies/Industry

- **US**-based app-based helicopter and small-planes aggregator, **Fly Blade** has announced that it is going to launch services from **Mumbai** starting March 2019.
 - In Mumbai, it will provide connectivity to Pune and Shirdi from the two active heliports in Mumbai, Mahalaxmi and Juhu.
- Adani Defence and Aerospace and Israel's Elbit Systems jointly inaugurated India's first private Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) manufacturing facility in Hyderabad.
 - The 50,000-square feet Adani Elbit UAV complex would also be the first outside Israel to manufacture Elbit's Hermes 900 Medium Altitude Long Endurance UAV.
- **Facebook** is developing '**stablecoin**', a type of cryptocurrency pegged to the dollar, for the payments feature on its messaging platform **WhatsApp**.
 - The social media giant's first focus will reportedly be India, the world's largest remittances market as per World Bank.
- American multinational technology company **Google** has selected 87 news organizations from 23 countries for funding under its **Global News Initiative** (GNI).
 - Of these 87 organizations selected, 10 are from India.
- **Coal India** for the first time has started using an indigenously-made, 205-tonne **electric dumper**, a critical piece of equipment in mining.
 - This indigenously-made dumper has been developed by state-owned BEML.

Exports/Imports

• **India** which is the largest producer and consumer of milk has extended the **ban** on import of milk products from **China** for 4 months.

Taxation/Trade

• China has rejected India's proposal to carry out bilateral trade in local currencies.

- The **US** and **China** have agreed to halt additional trade tariffs with the goal of reaching an agreement within 90 days.
 - This follows a meeting between US President **Donald Trump** and Chinese President **Xi Jinping** in Argentina.
- Pakistan is going to impose a 'sin' tax on cigarettes and sugary drinks.
 - The money collected with this Sin tax will be diverted to the health budget.

Space

- Elon Musk-led startup **SpaceX** successfully launched 64 satellites aboard its **Falcon 9 rocket** into Earth's orbit, setting a new US record.
 - The rocket carried India's first fully private satellite 'ExseedSat-1', built by Mumbai-based startup Exseed Space for less than Rs.2 crore.
- Russian space agency **Roscosmos** has announced the spaceflight **Soyuz MS-11** carrying 3 crew members, successfully docked at the **International Space Station** (ISS).
 - The members including female NASA astronaut Anne McClain will spend over six months on the Earth-orbiting laboratory.
- The **Indian Space Research Organization** (ISRO) successfully launched India's heaviest satellite **GSAT-11** from the European Spaceport in **French Guinana**.
 - France-headquartered Arianespace's Ariane-5 rocket successfully lifted off with communication satellite Gsat-11 and South Korean geo satellite Geo-Kompsat-2A.
 - Weighing 5854 kg, GSAT-11 will boost broadband speeds (at least 16 Gbps) and provide the capacity to meet growing demands for **internet connectivity**.
- Russian Ambassador to India Nikolay Kudashev announced that Russia is ready to assist India, particularly in training astronauts, for Gaganyaan (India's 1st manned mission to space) planned for 2022.
- The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) has announced that its Voyager 2 spacecraft became the second human-made object to leave the Solar System on November 5.
- US-based rocket propulsion company **Rocket Lab** launched 13 cube satellites on its **Electron rocket** from New Zealand into low Earth orbit for NASA's **ELaNa-19 mission**.
 - The rocket lifted off from the world's only private orbital launch pad on the **Mahia Peninsula**.
- The **Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO)** successfully launched its 35th communications satellite **GSAT-7A** from **Sriharikota**, **Andhra Pradesh**.
- The **National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA)** has created the coldest known place in the Universe inside NASA's **Cold Atom Laboratory (CAL)** at the International Space Station.
 - The researchers successfully produced clouds of "ultracold" atoms which can reach a fraction of a degree above absolute zero temperature.
- To offer broadband internet services to users worldwide, **China** has launched its 1st communication satellite.
 - The communication satellite was launched using a Long March 11 carrier rocket which took off from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Centre in north-western China.
 - It is CASIC's (China Aerospace Science and Industry Corporation) first satellite launch under China's Hongyun project.
- A Chinese space probe, **Chang'e-4**, has entered the elliptical lunar orbit in preparation to land on the dark side of the Moon for the first time.
 - The probe, carried by a **Long March-3B rocket**, had been launched earlier this month.
- China's BeiDou Navigation Satellite System (BDS) has started offering global service.
 - It is touted as a rival to America's **Global Positioning System (GPS)**.

- BeiDou Navigation Satellite System was the fourth global navigation system after US's GPS, Russia's GLONASS and the European Union's Galileo.
- Pakistan has become the 1st foreign nation to use the BeiDou system ending its reliance on GPS.

Science and Technology

- **Microsoft Azure** recently launched the **Virtual Assistant Accelerator** (VAA), which promises to develop conversational bots to enhance personalized content delivery across multiple devices.
- **German** firm **BigRep** and **NOWlab** produced the world's first fully functioning e-motorbike **NERA** using a 3D printer.
- Government policy think-tank **NITI Aayog** is developing a virtual assistant device like **Amazon's Alexa** for **Vernacular users**.
 - This device would be capable of handling queries in 18 languages.
 - **Vernacular** the language spoken by a particular group or in a particular area.

- Calling for elimination of industrially produced trans-fat in the food supply, the **Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI)** launched a media campaign titled "**Heart Attack Rewind**".
 - It will support FSSAI's global target of eliminating trans-fat in India by 2022, a year ahead of global target by World Health Organization (WHO).
- According to a recent report by the **Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR)**, 1 in every 8 deaths in India in 2017 was attributed to **Air Pollution**.
 - The report also stated that air pollution lowered the average life expectancy by 1.7 years.
- **Gujarat**-based cardiologist **Tejas Patel** conducted a heart surgery from 32 km away in the world's first in-human tele-robotic coronary intervention.
- To promote the medical devices sector, the government is going to set up a **National Medical Devices Promotion Council (NMDPC)** under the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) in the Ministry of Commerce & Industry.

 - This project will be funded under the 'Development of Wildlife Habitat (CSS-DWH)' scheme which is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme
